












Situation of 27 March 2017 edition of the hours 14-next update 29-03-2017 hours 14, forecaster: LL


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Generally clear with increasing temperatures from the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is present almost only to the N except for the main southern mountains where snow is present only above 1700-1800 m. The clear night and the decreasing temperatures led to load-bearing melt-freeze crusts. The snowpack is therefore generally consolidated and stable in the morning up to the highest altitudes. Temperatures will increase from the late morning (zero-degree line at 2200 m). Isolated releases will be possible from the afternoon, under rocks on very steep aspects. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory.

Forecast for Tuesday 28 March 2017, reliability: 90%





Forecast danger level: 1 (low), increasing to 2 (moderate) from the afternoon.

Forecast danger level: 1 (low), increasing to 2 (moderate) from the afternoon.
