












Situation of 18 April 2017 edition of the hours 14-next update 21-04-2017 hours 14, forecaster: LL



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The light snowfalls of previous days have brought 5-10 cm of fresh snow above 1200-1300 m, which doesn't change avalanche danger though. New snow lies directly on the ground almost everywhere, except for shady N slopes above 1900-2000 m, where old snow is present. The snowpack is well consolidated. In the afternoon possible loose snow releases from walls and very steep slopes under rocks. Then N winds and decreasing temperatures will lead to melt-freeze crusts almost everywhere. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) on the Carniche and Giulie Alps. No avalanche danger on the Prealps.

Forecast for Wednesday 19 April 2017, reliability: 80%

In the morning the snowpack will be stable, danger will increase in the afternoon.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Partly cloudy or variable sky. Cold strong winds from N.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Partly cloudy to variable with decreasing temperatures and zero-degree line at 1200 m. Cold N winds and the clear night will lead to melt-freeze crusts almost everywhere, so avalanche danger will remain low. Where the snowpack is present, isolated loose snow releases will be possible from walls and very steep slopes under rocks due to the sunshine. Caution on steep frozen aspects: dangerous falls may occur. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) on the Carniche and Giulie Alps. No avalanche danger on the Prealps.




Thermal Zero: 1200 m T.average 1000: 1 °C T.average 2000: -8 °C

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable sky. Cold strong winds from NE. Cold at altitude.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable sky; low temperatures with zero-degree line at 1200 m. Where the snowpack is present, isolated loose snow releases will be possible from walls and very steep slopes under rocks due to the sunshine. Caution on steep frozen aspects: dangerous falls may occur. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) on the Carniche and Giulie Alps. No avalanche danger on the Prealps.

Forecast for Friday 21 April 2017, reliability: 70%

In the morning the snowpack will be stable, danger will increase in the afternoon.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear sky. Still cold during the night.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Generally clear sky, slight increase in temperatures and zero-degree line at 1500 m. The snowpack, if present, will still be characterised by melt-freeze crusts almost everywhere. In the afternoon, isolated loose snow releases will be possible from very steep slopes under rocks due to the sunshine. Caution on steep frozen aspects: dangerous falls may occur. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) on the Carniche and Giulie Alps. No avalanche danger on the Prealps.
