


**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Partly cloudy; mostly cloudy on the Prealps.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Expected reversals on valley floors and high temperatures at altitude (thermal zero at 3200 m) with a consequent increasing danger. On the Alps possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches above the tree line during the warmer hours and on sunny slopes, even down to the valley floor on steeper green slopes. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) during the warmer hours. On the Prealps possible releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on the surface during the warmer hours and on steeper sunny slopes, generally low cohesive. Forecast danger level: 1 (low).

Forecast for Thursday 23 November 2017, reliability: 70%



**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Variable on the most inland areas; cloudy to overcast sky on the Prealps.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Expected still high temperatures at altitude and during the day. On the Alps possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches above the tree line during the warmer hours and on sunny slopes, even down to the valley floor on steeper green slopes. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) during the warmer hours. On the Prealps possible releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on the surface during the warmer hours and on steeper sunny slopes, generally low cohesive. Forecast danger level: 1 (low).

Forecast for Friday 24 November 2017, reliability: 70%



**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Mostly cloudy on the Prealps, variable or even partly cloudy at altitude on the Alps.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Expected slight temperature decrease (thermal zero at 2700 m), though temperatures at altitude and during the day are still high. On the Alps possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches above the tree line during the warmer hours and on sunny slopes, even down to the valley floor on steeper green slopes. Forecast danger level: 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) during the warmer hours. On the Prealps possible releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on the surface during the warmer hours and on steeper sunny slopes, generally low cohesive. Forecast danger level: 1 (low).

Forecast for Saturday 25 November 2017, reliability: 60%

**In the evening increasing snowfall danger with possible spontaneous and triggered avalanches.**

**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
From Saturday afternoon considerable worsening, abundant to heavy snowfalls on inland areas.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** In the morning, still variable sky and quite warm climate; from the afternoon a worsening is expected with a temperature decrease and abundant snowfalls (40-50 cm of snow at 1600-1700 m and even more at higher altitudes). In the evening considerable increasing danger related to the snowfall abundance. Across the whole alpine territory, above the tree line and on all aspects possible both spontaneous avalanches, even down to the valley floor on steeper green slopes, and triggered avalanches with low overload. Forecasts danger level: 1 (low) increasing to 3 (considerable) in the evening.
