

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:
Variable cloudiness; in the evening possible slight sleet on Tarvisio and on the surroundings.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: In the last few days 20 to 40 cm of new snow have fallen across the whole territory up to 500 m on the internal mountain and up to 700 m on the Prealps. The larger quantities have fallen on the Giulie Alps. The relatively low temperatures facilitate a slow and progressive consolidation. Still possible spontaneous releases of low cohesive small-sized avalanches on slopes and on steeper couloirs, especially to the South. In the most consistent accumulation zones possible triggered release of medium and small-sized avalanches, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps. Forecast danger level: 3 (considerable) on the Giulie Alps, 2 (moderate) on the Carnic Alps and on the Carnic and Giulie Prealps.

Forecast for Saturday 02 December 2017, reliability: 70%



Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:
Generally variable due to clouds at medium to higher altitude, with the risk of fully covered the sky.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Saturday there will be a strong North-eastern wind at altitude, the snow cover will be blown and new accumulations and slabs will be formed at all aspects, but especially to the South-West. Real triggered release danger, even with low overload in the accumulation zones and on new slabs up to 1700 m, thereby causing medium and small-sized avalanches. This may mostly occur on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin massif. Up to 1700 m possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches on couloirs and on steeper southern slopes. Forecast danger level: 3 (considerable) on the Giulie Alps, 2 (moderate) on the Carnic Alps and on the Carnic and Giulie Prealps.

Forecast for Sunday 03 December 2017, reliability: 70%

Triggered release danger on the Giulie Alps.


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Early in the morning residual clouds; later clear sky or partly cloudy. Night frosts on the mountains.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Sunday morning North-eastern wind, later softening during the day. Still low temperatures and mainly low-cohesive snow. Still possible triggered releases of medium and small-sized avalanches, even with low overload in the accumulation zones up to 1700 m. This may mostly occur on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin massif. Up to 1700 m possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches and releases on couloirs and on steeper southern slopes. Forecast danger level: 3 (considerable) on the Giulie Alps, 2 (moderate) on the Carnic Alps and on the Carnic and Giulie Prealps.

Forecast for Monday 04 December 2017, reliability: 70%

Possible triggered small-sized releases, generally due to a high overload on the Giulie Alps.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Partly cloudy to variable due to thick overcast at altitude.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Decreasing danger on Monday, thanks to the slight temperature increase, which will aid the snow cover consolidation. There will be a strong North-Western wind blowing the snow cover. Possible triggered releases with a generally high overload up to 1800 m in the accumulation zones, below ridges and forks and along the steeper northern couloirs. Still possible releases and small-sized avalanches on steeper slopes and on popular trails exposed to the sun. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate) across the whole mountainous region.
