

Situation of 18 December 2017 edition of the hours 14-next update 21-12-2017 hours 14, forecaster: LL **Possible triggered avalanches, locally with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps.**



Possible triggered avalanches, locally with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowcover has been reshaped by the wind. It has some eroded areas with crusts formed by regelation and with wind accumulations, due to the recent snowfall; theese accumulations are generally small-sized and localised in the couloirs above the tree line. Same situation on the Prealps at the highest altitudes in the northern aspects. Still possible triggered small-sized slab releases, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps, along the couloirs and below ridges and steeper forks above 1800m. This is less likely on the Carnic Alps and isolated and restricted to the highest altitudes of the major massifs on the Prealps. Across the whole territory, the avalanche activity is limited to some releases on the steeper slopes exposed to the sun. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate) on the Alps, 1 (low) on the Prealps.

Forecast for Tuesday 19 December 2017, reliability: 70% Possible triggered avalanches, locally with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear sky or partly cloudy during the day, cloudy in the evening; low temperatures. Still possible triggered small-sized slab releases, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps, along the couloirs and below ridges and steeper forks above 1800m. This is less likely on the Carnic Alps and isolated and restricted to the highest altitudes of the major massifs on the Prealps. Across the whole territory, the avalanche activity is limited to some releases on the steeper slopes exposed to the sun. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate) on the Alps, 1 (low) on the Prealps.

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




Forecast for Wednesday 20 December 2017, reliability: 70% Possible triggered avalanches, locally with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable during the night and in the early morning. Clear sky during the day; low temperatures. Still possible triggered small-sized slab releases, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps, along the couloirs and below ridges and steeper forks above 1800m. This is less likely on the Carnic Alps and isolated and restricted to the highest altitudes of the major massifs on the Prealps. Across the whole territory, the avalanche activity is limited to some releases on the steeper slopes exposed to the sun. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate) on the Alps, 1 (low) on the Prealps.

Forecast for Thursday 21 December 2017, reliability: 60% Possible triggered avalanches, locally with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear sky or partly cloudy, low temperatures during the day, but thermal zero altitude increase up to over 2000m in the evening. Still possible triggered small-sized slab releases, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps, along the couloirs and below ridges and steeper forks above 1800m. This is less likely on the Carnic Alps and isolated and restricted to the highest altitudes of the major massifs on the Prealps. Across the whole territory, the avalanche activity is limited to some releases on the steeper slopes exposed to the sun. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate) on the Alps, 1 (low) on the Prealps.
