








Partly cloudy, variable in the afternoon. Thermal inversion.



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** The snow cover is characterised by recent small-sized accumulations related to the last snowfall, locally unstable. These accumulations lay on old and solid wind drift accumulations, which are generally well consolidated. Moderate danger level (2) on the Giulie Alps. Still possible release above the tree line in the accumulation zones, triggered with a generally high overload. Pay attention to the accumulations below ridges and forks on the northern aspects, where releases may be triggered even by a single skier/hiker. Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps, related to the old accumulations, which could cause a triggered release on the northern aspects with a generally high overload. Not to be excluded the release even with low overload on very steep slopes and locally at the highest altitudes. Possible isolated spontaneous releases during the warmer hours on the steepest slopes.

## Forecast for Saturday 17 February 2018, reliability: 80%

## Avalanche danger, locally triggered even with low overload.

Partly cloudy in the morning, overcast later. Possible very slight snowfall above 500 m in the evening.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Partly cloudy in the morning, cloudy to overcast during the day. Moderate danger level (2) on the Giulie Alps. Still possible release above the tree line in the accumulation zones, triggered with a generally high overload. Pay attention to the accumulations below ridges and forks on the northern aspects, where releases may be triggered even by a single skier/hiker. Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps, related to the old accumulations, which could cause a triggered release on the northern aspects with a generally high overload. Not to be excluded the release even with low overload on very steep slopes and locally at the highest altitudes. Possible isolated spontaneous releases during the warmer hours on the steepest slopes.




#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Possible slight scattered precipitations during the night, sleet above 400 m. Variable

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still cloudy and possible sleet on the Western Carnia. Moderate danger level (2) on the Giulie Alps. Still possible release above the tree line in the accumulation zones, triggered with a generally high overload. Pay attention to the accumulations below ridges and forks on the northern aspects, where releases may be triggered even by a single skier/hiker. Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps, related to the old accumulations, which could cause a triggered release on the northern aspects with a generally high overload. Not to be excluded the release even with low overload on very steep slopes and locally at the highest altitudes. Possible isolated spontaneous releases during the warmer hours on the steepest slopes.

Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps, related to the old accumulations, which could cause a triggered release on the northern aspects with a generally high overload. Not to be excluded the release even with low overload on very steep slopes and locally at the highest altitudes. Possible isolated spontaneous releases during the warmer hours on the steepest slopes.
