
## AVALANCHE BULLETIN n.51 the 09 March 2018



Situation of 09 March 2018 edition of the hours 14-next update 12-03-2018 hours 14, forecaster: LL



#### Avalanche danger, locally triggered even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still wind drift accumulations not well consolidated, especially to the northern aspects and above 1700-1800 m, which could cause some releases with a generally high overload. In these aspects, but in the areas close to ridges and forks and on very steep slopes, possible release triggered by a single skier/hiker. Still possible local low-cohesive releases on very steep slopes and close to cliffs. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate).

# Forecast for Saturday 10 March 2018, reliability: 60% **Avalanche danger, locally triggered even with low overload.**



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Overcast, slight precipitations from the late afternoon. Possible local release in the accumulation zones above 1800 m, especially to the N, generally triggered with a high overload. To the N, but in the areas close to ridges and forks and on very steep slopes, possible release triggered by a single skier/hiker. Still possible local low-cohesive releases on very steep slopes and close to cliffs from the afternoon. Forecast danger level: 2 (moderate).

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


### Forecast for Sunday 11 March 2018, reliability: 60%

#### Possible spontaneous avalanches from the afternoon due to new abundant rainfalls and snowfalls.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast, slight precipitations in the morning and more abundant precipitations in the afternoon. The snow line is uncertain (between 1500 and 1900 m), lower to the Cadore but with smaller quantities, higher on the Prealps, where the snow will be more abundant. Possible spontaneous avalanches of wet or moist snow from the afternoon, which could be of medium size in some cases, below 1800-1900 m. Possible both slab and low-cohesive avalanches above 2000 m, even of medium size, on very steep slopes on all aspects. The release may be triggered even by a single skier/hiker. Forecast danger level: 3 (considerable).

# Forecast for Monday 12 March 2018, reliability: 60% Still spontaneous medium-sized avalanche danger.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable cloudiness, more persistent on the Prealps, residual precipitations in the morning. Possible spontaneous avalanche of wet or moist snow, which could be of medium size in some cases, below 1800-1900 m on all aspects. Possible both slab and low-cohesive avalanches above 2000 m, even of medium size, on very steep slopes. The release may be triggered even by a single skier/hiker above 1500 m. Forecast danger level: 3 (considerable).
