






Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The strong N-NE winds strongly reshaped the snow cover and formed new accumulations on all aspects. New weak layers formed on old crusts covered by the new snow, due to low temperatures and clear sky. Considerable danger level (3) on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin group. In this area, on steep slopes above the tree line the accumulations are very tough and they could be released by the passage of a single skier/hiker (low overload), possible even medium-sized avalanches. Moderate danger level (2) across the rest of the territory. The triggered release of small-sized avalanches may occur with a generally high overload. However it may occur even with low overload in the accumulation zones on the steepest slopes above 2000 m. Possible releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on leeward steep slopes and on the slopes most exposed to the sun.

Forecast for Saturday 24 March 2018, reliability: 80%

## **Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:** Partly cloudy, local and more consistent

Partly cloudy, local and more consistent clouds on the Carnic Prealps in the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The wind activity of the last few days, forming accumulations on all aspects, is decreasing. Possible weak layers due to clear sky and low temperatures. Considerable danger level (3) on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin group. Possible triggered release of avalanches, even of medium size, with low overload in this area, on very steep slopes in the accumulation zones above the tree line. Moderate danger level (2) across the rest of the territory. The triggered release of small-sized avalanches may occur with a generally high overload. However it may occur even with low overload in the accumulation zones on the steepest slopes below ridges and forks, above 2000 m. The spontaneous avalanche activity is limited to releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on leeward steep slopes and on the slopes most exposed to the sun.








Forecast for Sunday 25 March 2018, reliability: 70%


### Triggered avalanche danger, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin.



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Considerable danger level (3) on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin group. Still possible triggered release of avalanches, even of medium size, with low overload in this area, on very steep slopes in the accumulation zones above the tree line. Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps. The triggered release of small-sized avalanches may occur with a generally high overload. However it may occur even with low overload in the accumulation zones on the steepest slopes below ridges and forks, above 1800 m. The spontaneous avalanche activity is limited to releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on leeward steep slopes and on the slopes most exposed to the sun.

Forecast for Monday 26 March 2018, reliability: 60%

#### Triggered avalanche danger, even with low overload, especially on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Considerable danger level (3) on the Giulie Alps and on the Canin group. Still possible triggered release of avalanches, even of medium size, with low overload in this area, on very steep slopes in the accumulation zones above the tree line. Moderate danger level (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps. The triggered release of small-sized avalanches may occur with a generally high overload. However be careful above 2000 m, in the accumulation zones on the steepest slopes, where the release may occur even with low overload. The spontaneous avalanche activity is limited to releases and spontaneous small-sized avalanches on leeward steep slopes and on the slopes most exposed to the sun.
