




Situation of 28 March 2018 edition of the hours 14-next update 30-03-2018 hours 14, forecaster: DM


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable cloudiness, possible scattered precipitations from the late afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Slight snow fell on the mountain area, with minimum contributions. Moderate danger level (2) on the Alps. Above 2000 m on shady aspects the releases of slab avalanches (generally of small size) may be triggered with a high overload, in the accumulation zones not yet consolidated. Possible spontaneous avalanches on southern slopes, even to the valley floor where there are cracks and whale mouths (crevices) on the snow cover. On the Prealps the snow cover is more consolidated and in the morning the danger level is low (1), increasing to 2 (moderate) during the warmest hours, when spontaneous small and medium-sized avalanches may occur on steep slopes exposed to the sun. The triggered release is still possible with a generally high overload only below ridges and along the steepest couloirs at the highest altitudes.

Forecast for Thursday 29 March 2018, reliability: 70%

Increasing danger due to new precipitations, snow only above 1600-1700 m.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Scattered precipitations, abundant to intense, especially on the Prealps (to the E), snow above 1300-1600 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: An Atlantic front will affect our region on Thursday, 20 to 30 cm of new snow will fall above 1300-1600 m, more snow on the Giulie Alps. The avalanche danger will increase to 3 (considerable) across the whole territory, but especially on the Giulie Alps. Possible release of spontaneous avalanches (of small or medium size) above 1800 m, on all aspects and along the usual paths, even to the valley floor where there are cracks and whale mouths (crevices) on the snowpack. Below this altitude the snowpack will be heavier due to the moist snow or the rain. The triggered release may occur even with low overload in the areas where the new snow is more abundant.








Forecast for Friday 30 March 2018, reliability: 70%

Considerable avalanche danger due to new snow above 1800 m and due to rain below this altitude.


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Scattered and abundant precipitations, especially on the Prealps. Snowfalls above 1500-1700 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Low-pressure areas on Friday and more intense precipitations in the evening, 30 to 60 cm of new snow may fall above 1800 m. Considerable avalanche danger (3) across the whole territory. Possible spontaneous releases of low-cohesive and slab avalanches (of small or medium size) of moist or wet snow on the steepest slopes and along the usual paths on all aspects, even on green slopes to the valley floor. Possible triggered release even with low overload above 1800 m, on the steepest slopes and where there is a major quantity of new snow.

Forecast for Saturday 31 March 2018, reliability: 60%

Increasing danger due to new abundant snowfalls expected above 1800 m.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Abundant to intense precipitations, snow above 1600-1800 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Saturday expected new abundant snowfalls on our mountains above 1800 m. The new snow will add up to the abundant snow of the last few days and the danger level will be high (4) across the whole mountain territory. Possible releases of small and medium-sized avalanches and even larged-sized avalanches along the usual paths on all aspects, even below the level of snowfalls made heavier by the rain. Some avalanches may convey along the steepest couloirs and may affect the practicability above 1100 m. On the Giulie Alps, where there will be more snow, the avalanche activity will be more strong. Above 1800 m the triggered release may occur even with low overload, on steep slopes on all aspects. The avalanche danger could vary locally, depending on the snow quantity.
