












Situation of 30 March 2018 edition of the hours 14-next update 03-04-2018 hours 14, forecaster: DM/MM


Variable weather, new precipitations in the evening, abundant snowfalls above 1500-1700 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The low-pressure area on our Region on Thursday brought rather high temperatures and 30 to 50 cm of new snow above 1800-2000 m, across the whole mountain territory, more abundant snow fell on the Giulie Alps. The avalanche danger is considerable (3) on the Giulie Alps and Prealps, where low-cohesive and soaked snow avalanches (of small and medium size) may occur along the usual paths, on all aspects. The triggered release may occur even with low overload above 1800 m. Moderate avalanche danger (2) on the Carnic Alps and Prealps, because there is less new snow there; the snowpack is anyway made heavier by the rain and so small and medium-sized releases may occur along the usual paths.

Forecast for Saturday 31 March 2018, reliability: 70%

Possible spontaneous medium-sized avalanches. High danger level (4) on the Giulie Alps and Prealps.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Abundant snowfalls during the night and in the morning, especially on the Giulie Prealps and E-Carnia, above 1700m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The low-pressure area expected during the night between Friday and Saturday will bring new snow above 1700-1800 m (30 to 50 cm on the Carnic Alps, 70 to 100 cm on the Giulie. High danger level (4) on the Giulie Alps and Prealps, possible release of small and medium-sized avalanches and in some cases large-sized avalanches along the usual paths on all aspects, even below the snow line due to the rain weighting. Some of these avalanches may convey along the steepest couloirs and may affect the practicability above 1100 m. On the Carnic Alps and Prealps, where there will be less snow, the avalanche danger will be considerable (3) and the spontaneous releases will be of small or medium size along the usual paths. The triggered release may occur even with low overload across the whole territory, due to the rain weighting.








Forecast for Sunday 01 April 2018, reliability: 70%

Possible spontaneous medium-sized avalanches. High danger level (4) on the Giulie Alps and Prealps.


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Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable, cloudy in the morning and clears. Possible downpours in the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Better weather on Sunday, the avalanche danger will still be high (4) on the Giulie Alps and Prealps, where the releases of small and medium-sized avalanches and in some cases large-sized avalanches may occur along the usual paths on all aspects, even below the snow line due to the rain weighting. Some of these avalanches may convey along the steepest couloirs and may affect the practicability above 1100 m. On the Carnic Alps and Prealps, the avalanche danger will be considerable (3) and the spontaneous releases will be of small or medium size along the usual paths. The triggered release may occur even with low overload across the whole territory, due to the rain weighting.

Forecast for Monday 02 April 2018, reliability: 70%

Possible both spontaneous and triggered avalanches on steep slopes during the warmest hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Decent weather on Monday, temperature increase in the late morning. On the Giulie Alps and Prealps the avalanche danger will be considerable (3), due to the releases of spontaneous avalanches (of small or medium size) on steep slopes and along the usual paths on all aspects, but especially to the S and in the late morning. Possible releases triggered by a low overload above 1800. On the Carnic Alps and Prealps the avalanche danger will be moderate (2) in the morning, increasing to considerable (3) during the warmest hours, due to possible spontaneous avalanches of small or medium size along the usual paths, especially to the S. Possible triggered release even with low overload in areas affected by new snow.
