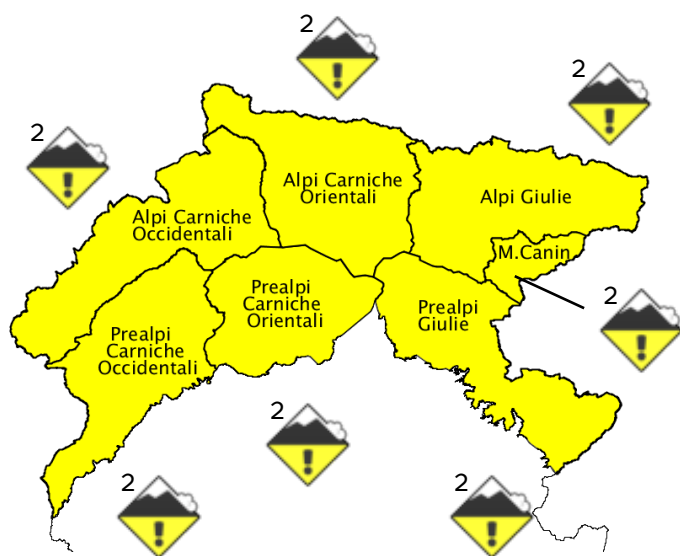


Situation of 09 April 2018 edition of the hours 14-next update 11-04-2018 hours 14, forecaster: GA

reliability: 80%

**Moderate danger level (2) from the afternoon, due to thermal increase and new precipitations.**

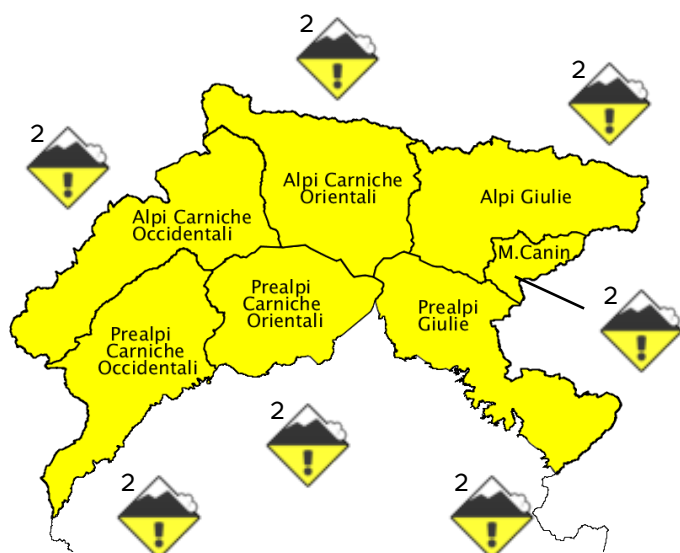
**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Cloudy and slight or moderate precipitations from the afternoon.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Moderate avalanche danger (2) for this afternoon across the whole mountain territory. The thermal increase during the day and the expected precipitations (10 to 20 cm of new snow at high altitude and rain below) will favour the spontaneous release of small-sized avalanches, generally superficial, on the steepest slopes on all aspects. Possible slab releases on slopes with cracks or crevices on the snowpack, the so called "whale mouths". In these areas the releases may occur to the valley floor and may even be of medium size. The triggered release may occur by skiing, especially on steep slopes and on all aspects.

Forecast for Tuesday 10 April 2018, reliability: 70%

**Possible both spontaneous and triggered avalanches on steepest slopes during the warmest hours.**

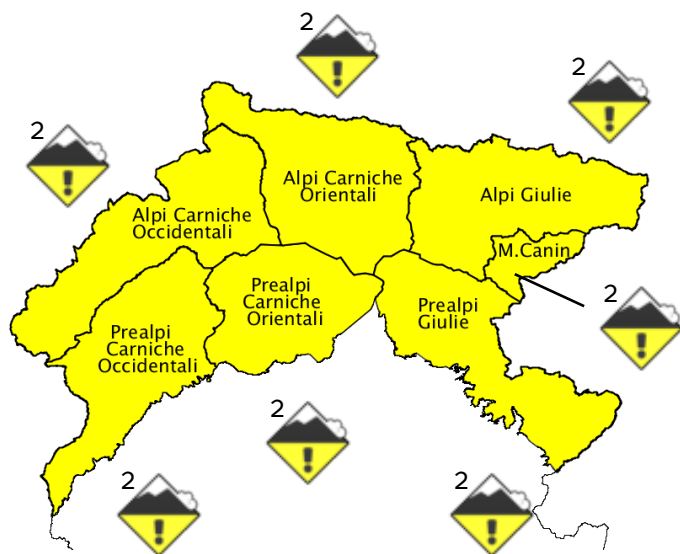

**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Overcast, moderate precipitations, snow above 1700 m.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Expected variable weather, possible precipitations (snow at high altitude, 5 to 15 cm of new snow). The clouds expected during the night will prevent the superficial layers of the snowpack to freeze, despite the expected slight temperature decrease. Moderate avalanche danger (2). Possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches from the late morning on the steepest slopes on all aspects. Possible medium-sized releases, even to the valley floor, on slopes with cracks and crevices on the snowpack, the so called "whale mouths", especially during the warmest hours. Possible release triggered even by a single skier/hiker, especially on very steep slopes.

Forecast for Wednesday 11 April 2018, reliability: 70%

**Possible both spontaneous and triggered avalanches on steepest slopes during the warmest hours.**

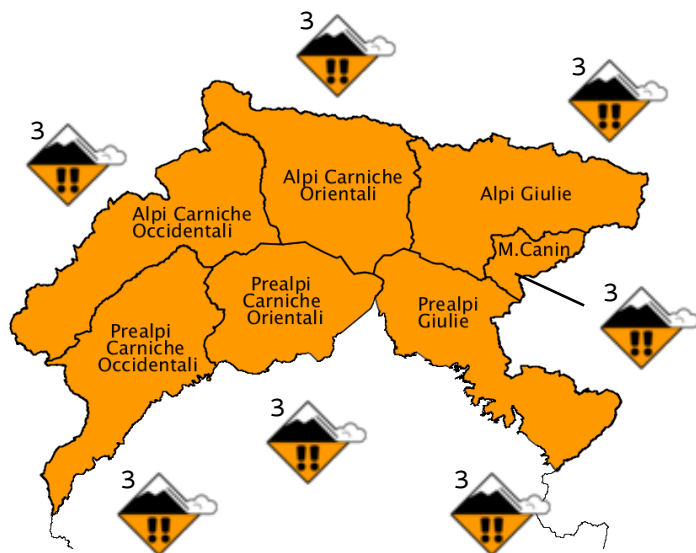

**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Cloudy, low-probable scattered and short precipitations.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Expected variable sky, possible scattered snowfalls at high altitude. Moderate avalanche danger (2) across the whole mountain territory. Possible spontaneous small-sized avalanches from the late morning on the steepest slopes on all aspects. Possible medium-sized releases, even to the valley floor, on slopes with cracks and crevices on the snowpack, the so called "whale mouths", especially during the warmest hours. Possible release triggered even by a single skier/hiker, especially on very steep slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 12 April 2018, reliability: 70%

**Considerable danger level (3) due to new abundant precipitations.**

**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Overcast, widespread snowfalls above 1600 m.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Overcast, abundant precipitations, snowfalls above 1700-1900 m, 30 to 40 cm of new snow. Considerable danger level (3) across the whole mountain territory. Possible spontaneous avalanches (of small or medium size) during the day, along the usual paths on all aspects. Possible release triggered by a single skier/hiker and possible even medium-sized releases.
