


Situation of 23 April 2018 edition of the hours 14-next update 24-04-2018 hours 14, forecaster: DM/MM

Possible widespread releases during the warmest hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still very high temperatures, even at altitude. The snowpack is generally stable and well consolidated in the morning, with some superficial crusts, even load-bearing ones. The superficial layers melt from the late morning and releases of small-sized low-cohesive avalanches may occur on the steepest slopes (more than 35 degrees), starting from eastern aspects until the western aspects, going through the South. The melting is emphasised by the presence of desert sand set down on the surface during the last precipitations, to the S the releases may occur to the valley floor and may be slab releases. Possible release of small-sized avalanches of soaked snow from the late morning, triggered even by skiing. Low avalanche danger (1) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) from the late morning.

Forecast for Tuesday 24 April 2018, reliability: 80% **Possible widespread superficial releases on all aspects**.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Tuesday a slight weather front will bring some rainfalls up to the highest altitudes. Moderate avalanche danger (2) for the whole day, due to the insufficient nocturnal refreeze. Possible limited releases of low-cohesive snow during the warmest hours on the steepest slopes on all aspects. The triggered release of small-sized avalanches of soaked snow may occur even by skiing from the morning on the steepest slopes.



Forecast for Wednesday 25 April 2018, reliability: 80% **Possible widespread releases during the warmest hours.**



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still very high temperatures at altitude on Wednesday. The lacking cloud cover during the night will favour the refreeze of the superficial layers. Low avalanche danger (1) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) form the late morning. Possible releases of small-sized low-cohesive avalanches on the steepest slopes (more than 35 degrees), starting from the eastern aspects until the western aspects, going through the South. Possible release of small-sized low-cohesive evaluanches of small-sized avalanches of soaked snow on the steepest slopes, triggered even by skiing.

Forecast for Thursday 26 April 2018, reliability: 70% **Possible widespread superficial releases on all aspects**.
