

#### Widespread releases and some superficial small-sized avalanches of wet snow.




**AVALANCHE BULLETIN** 

n.70 the 24 April 2018

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Slight rainfalls occurred on the mountain area up to the highest altitudes. The temperatures slight decreased, but they are still high for this season, with thermal zero at 3100 m. Possible isolated downpours this afternoon. Moderate avalanche danger (2) across the whole mountain territory. Expected releases and some superficial small-sized avalanches of wet snow on the steepest slopes on all aspects. Not to exclude the release of isolated medium-sized avalanches on extreme slopes, below 2200 m; these avalanches may even occur to the valley floor in the areas with cracks and crevices on the snowpack. The release of small-sized avalanches of wet snow may be triggered by skiing on the steepest slopes.

# Forecast for Wednesday 25 April 2018, reliability: 80%

Possible releases and superficial small-sized avalanches of wet snow from the late morning.



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Quite good weather and new thermal increase in the morning. Possible isolated local downpours in the afternoon. The refreeze of the superficial layer of the snowpack is moderate up to 2200-2300 m. Low avalanche danger (1) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from the late morning. Possible releases and superficial small-sized low-cohesive avalanches on the steepest slopes, starting from the E-aspects and extending to the other aspects as a result of the diurnal thermal increase and of the solar radiation. Isolated medium-size avalanches may occur to the valley floor on extreme slopes below 2200 m, in the areas with cracks and crevices on the snowpack. Possible release of small-sized avalanches of wet snow triggered by skiing from the late morning.




### AVALANCHE BULLETIN n.70 the 24 April 2018



Forecast for Thursday 26 April 2018, reliability: 70%


Possible releases and superficial small-sized avalanches of wet snow from the late morning.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Quite good weather in the morning, cloudy and moderate precipitations from the afternoon, rainfalls up to the highest altitudes. Low avalanche danger (1) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from the late morning, due to the thermal increase, the extensive cloud cover and the expected rain. Probable releases and superficial small-sized low-cohesive avalanches of wet or soaked snow. Medium-sized avalanches may occur locally, even to the valley floor on green slopes at cracks and crevices on the snowpack. Possible release of small-sized avalanches of wet or soaked snow triggered by skiing from the late morning.

## Forecast for Friday 27 April 2018, reliability: 70%

### Possible releases and superficial small-sized avalanches of wet snow from the late morning.



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Generally partly cloudy, slight thermal decrease. Moderate consolidation of the superficial layer of the snowpack up to 2200-2300. Low avalanche danger (1) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from the late morning. Possible releases and superficial small-sized low-cohesive avalanches on the steepest slopes, starting from the E-aspects and extending to the other aspects as a result of the diurnal thermal increase and of the solar radiation. Isolated medium-size avalanches may occur to the valley floor on extreme slopes below 2200 m, in the areas with cracks and crevices on the snowpack. Possible release of small-sized avalanches of wet snow triggered by skiing from the late morning.
