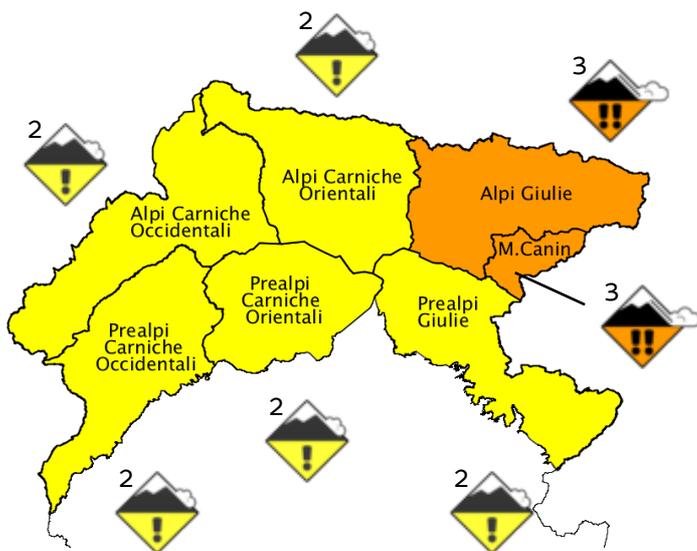


Situation of 30 January 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 01-02-2019 hours 14, forecaster: DM


Cloudy sky with clear spells to the East in the morning, cloudy sky everywhere from the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is slowly bonding. On the Julian and Canin the avalanche danger is 3 (considerable). Above 1700 m, on several steep slopes, exposed to the North, wind deposits are present not well bonded yet with weak layers at the base. Such deposits, if overloaded, can also cause triggering even at a single person passage, generating medium avalanches. Great caution and local assessment capacity of the danger is still required during excursions. The natural avalanche activity is decreasing limited to triggering and small avalanches. The danger is 2 (moderate) on the Carnic Alps and the Pre-Alps. In these areas the deposits are localized, have limited thicknesses and are easily recognizable. However, above 1800 m and in particular on northern exposures, if stressed, they can cause triggering locally even at a single person passage. Possible small natural avalanches on steep slopes, particularly to the South.

Forecast for Thursday 31 January 2019, reliability: 80%


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Cloudy or covered sky in the morning, variable in the afternoon. Possible slight snowfalls during the night.


Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Julian Alps and Canin Mountain avalanche danger is decreasing to 2 (moderate) thus conforming to the rest of the mountain territory. Particularly on this area to the north above 1600-1700 m, on many steep slopes there are wind deposits, even substantial, laying on weak layers below. Such deposits, if overloaded, can also cause triggering even at a single person passage, generating medium avalanches in general. On the rest of the territory this eventuality is minor due to the lower quantity of snow present. Everywhere the natural avalanche activity will be limited to triggering and small avalanches, in particular from the slopes exposed to the south.

Forecast for Friday 01 February 2019, reliability: 70%

Danger increasing from the afternoon due to the arrival of new snowfall.


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Slight snowfalls in the morning, in the afternoon abundant with snow gradually rising up to 1000 1500 m. of altitude

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: In the morning avalanche danger will be still 2 (moderate) everywhere and the most critical condition refers to the possibility of causing triggering even with low overload in the accumulation areas located above 1700 m, in particular on the northern exposures due to the presence of weak layers at the base. In the afternoon, with the arrival of new snowfalls, initially expected up to low altitudes, the danger will gradually increase until it becomes 3 (considerable) everywhere in the evening. From the evening, medium and very large natural avalanches are possible from the steepest usual routes located at all the exposures.

Forecast for Saturday 02 February 2019, reliability: 60%

Danger avalanches from high to very high due to the expected intensive snowfalls at altitude.

Very intensive precipitations with snowfalls above 1500, towards Cadore above about 1000 m. Strong winds from South

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During the night between Friday and Saturday and during the day on Saturday there will be very intense rainfalls with the snow altitude that will vary between 1200 and 1700 m. On the Pre-Alps it can rain even above 1800 m. The quantities of new snow accumulated at 2000 m can be quite substantial (150-200 cm) the avalanche danger already high everywhere in the morning, on the Alpine belt during the day can rise up to very high. Given the instability of the basal layers of the snowpack, avalanches of large dimensions will be possible on all the exposures, in some cases even extremely large and ground avalanches. Some of these by their going down along the gullies will be able to affect the ordinary road network over 800-1000 m of altitude. Over 1500 m the caused triggering will be possible even with low overload everywhere. Expected danger level: 4 (high) everywhere, rising to 5 (very high) during the day on the Carnic and Julian and Canin Alps.
