


Situation of 01 February 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 04-02-2019 hours 14, forecaster: DM


Heavy snowfalls, very heavy in the afternoon, initially over 500 m then up to 1800 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Already in the night the first precipitations began, snowy to the bottom of the valley. The altitude of the snow is however increasing rapidly due to the rise in temperature and it should rain up to about 1700-1800 m on the Pre-Alps and 1200 on the Alps. The most intense rainfalls are expected on the Alps and the Julian Prealps. In the morning the avalanche danger will still be 2 (moderate) everywhere and the most critical condition refers to the possibility of causing triggering even with low overload on the deposit areas located above 1700 m, in particular at the northern exposures due to the presence of weak basis. From the afternoon the danger will gradually increase up to 3 (considerable) everywhere. From the evening on the Alpine belt, medium and large natural avalanches are possible from the steepest usual routes at all the exposures.

Forecast for Saturday 02 February 2019, reliability: 70%

Very high avalanche danger on the ALPS due to heavy snowfalls expected at altitude.






Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Very heavy precipitations, snowy on Pre-Alps above 1800, above 1500 on high Carnia, 1000-1200 in Sappada.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Between Friday and Saturday heavy precipitations are expected, snowy on the Pre-Alps above 1500-1800 m only. In inland areas (Sauris, Forni Avoltri and Sappada) the altitude of the snow will be lower, about 1200 m. The quantities can be large everywhere (150-200 cm on the Julian and Canin - 100-150 elsewhere) but only above 1800-2000 m. On the Alpine belt the avalanche danger will be strong already in the morning. Given the instability of the basal layers will be possible to have medium and large avalanche at all the exposures, in some cases also very large and full depth slab avalanche. Some of these be falling along the gullies may affect the ordinary road network over 800-1000 m. Over 1500 m the triggering will be possible even with low additional overload everywhere. On the Pre-Alps the danger will be smaller as it will rain up to very high altitudes. Expected danger level: 4 (high) on the Carnic, Julian and Canin Alps, 3 (considerable) on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps. Prealps.

Forecast for Sunday 03 February 2019, reliability: 70%

High avalanche danger on the Alps due to new fallen unbonded snow.



Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:
Sky from variable to cloudy, possible slight showers locally.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Sunday possible natural dry-snow slab avalanches both dry-snow slab avalanches and dry loose snow medium and large avalanches and in some cases very large too at all the exposures and along the usual and cross routes. The ordinary road network above the 800-1000 m will still be affected on the Alpine belt. The caused triggering will be possible even with low additional overload over 1500 m, at all exposures. Expected danger level: 4 (high) on the Carnic, Julian and Canin Alps, 3 (considerable) on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Forecast for Monday 04 February 2019, reliability: 70%

Avalanche danger possible both natural and caused by the snow not bonded yet.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:
Little cloudy or variable sky.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Monday, on the Alpine belt will still be possible medium and large natural avalanches from the slopes without triggering yet, in particular on the Southern exposures. The snowpack will in any case undergoing firmness, so the danger will drop to 3 (considerable). Beyond the forest limit the triggering will be possible even with low additional overload at all the exposures, but in particular at the Northern exposures where the greatest deposits of snow are present. Danger level on the Pre-Alps will be 2 (moderate) and the caused triggering will be possible above 1800 m only under ridges and crossings and along the steepest gullies.
