


Mostly clear or little cloudy skies. Significant increase in maximum temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Increase in temperatures with freezing level at about 2200 m. On the Carnic and Julian Alps and the Canin avalanche danger is 2 (moderate). Given the strong Northern winds that occurred during the weekend, in deposit areas located on very steep slopes under the ridges and passes above 1900 m, it is possible to generate triggering of small/medium size mainly with high additional load at all exposures. On the Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps the avalanche danger is 1 (low): to the North, on the extremely steep slopes, triggering of small avalanches is possible at higher altitudes, especially with high additional load. Possible icy sections everywhere.

## Forecast for Tuesday 26 February 2019, reliability: 80%

### Increase in temperatures at altitude as well.

# Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Cloudy or temporarily variable sky, mild temperatures at altitude as well.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Temperatures will increase significantly even at altitude with a freezing level above 3000 m. On the Carnic and Julian Alps and the Canin avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate). During the hottest hours in particular, in deposit areas located on very steep slopes under the ridges and passes above 1900 m, it is possible to generate triggering of small/medium size mainly with high additional load at all exposures. On the Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps the avalanche danger will be 1 (low): to the North, on the extremely steep slopes, triggering of small avalanches is possible at higher altitudes, especially with high additional load. Possible icy sections everywhere.








# Forecast for Wednesday 27 February 2019, reliability: 80%

### Danger of avalanche triggering both natural and caused during the hottest hours.

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

#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear or little cloudy skies. Mild temperatures in particular in the valley bottoms.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) on the Carnic and Julian Alps and the Canin. The snowpack, due to the very mild temperatures at altitude as well, will take on typical spring characteristics. During the hottest hours, the surface layers of the snowpack will tend to weaken, thus favoring small and medium avalanche triggering from Southern exposures. Always during the hottest hours, it will be possible to cause triggering, usually with high additional load, in the deposit areas located under the steepest ridges and passes, at all exposures. On the Carnic and Julian the avalanche danger will be 1 (low): to the North, on the extremely steep slopes, the triggering of small avalanches will be possible at higher altitudes, especially with high additional load. Possible icy sections everywhere for melt-freeze cycles.

## Forecast for Thursday 28 February 2019, reliability: 80%

### Danger for both natural and caused avalanche triggering during the hottest hours.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Mostly clear or little cloudy skies. Still high temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) on the Carnic and Julian Alps and the Canin. Very mild temperatures are still expected and spring conditions for the snowpack. During the hottest hours, the surface layers of the snowpack will tend to weaken, thus favoring small and medium avalanche triggering from Southern exposures. Always during the hottest hours, it will be possible to cause triggering, usually with high additional load, in the deposit areas located under the steepest ridges and passes, at all exposures. On the Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps the avalanche danger will be 1 (low): to the North, on the extremely steep slopes, the triggering of small avalanches will be possible at higher altitudes, especially with high additional load. Possible icy sections everywhere for melt-freeze cycles.
