

Situation of 27 February 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 01-03-2019 hours 14, forecaster: MD

Avalanche danger is 1 (low)in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) during hottest hours.






Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: High temperatures for the period even at altitude, the freezing level for today will be at 2700 m. The snowpack has typically spring characteristics with not breakable surface crusts in the morning that are weakening during the hottest hours and tending to melt. Everywhere there are icy sections. At altitude, the wind has heavily altered the snowpack and many deposits alternate with eroded areas. The possibility of avalanches triggering is limited to the areas under the ridge and along the steep slopes, generally with high additional load. Natural avalanche activity is almost absent. The avalanche danger is 1 (low) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) during the hottest hours everywhere.

Forecast for Thursday 28 February 2019, reliability: 80%





Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: For Thursday the freezing level will be at about 3000 m. The snowpack will still have typically spring characteristics with not breakable surface crusts by melt and re-freeze in the morning that are weakening during the hottest hours and tending to melt. Everywhere there will be icy sections. Snowdrift deposits will be still significant at altitude, alternated with eroded areas. The possibility of avalanches triggering is limited to the areas under the ridge and along the steep slopes exposed to the North, generally with high additional load and during the hottest hours. Natural avalanche activity is almost absent. The avalanche danger will continue to be 1 (low) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) during the hottest hours everywhere.

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


Forecast for Friday 01 March 2019, reliability: 80%

Avalanche danger is 1 (low) everywhere.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Freezing level for Friday will be decreasing to about 2000 m and the slight transit of a perturbation from the North will lead to slight snowfalls in particular along the border ridge with Austria and Slovenia, without any influence on the avalanche danger. mainly, the snowpack will be strong and well bonded with bearing surface melt-freeze crusts. Everywhere there will be icy sections that can cause ruinous falls. Snowdrift deposits will be still significant at altitude, alternated with eroded areas. The possibility of avalanches triggering will be very low and limited to the areas under the ridge and along the steep slopes exposed to the far North and generally with high additional load. Natural avalanche activity is absent. The avalanche danger will be 1 (low) everywhere.

Forecast for Saturday 02 March 2019, reliability: 80% Avalanche danger si 1 (low) everywhere.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: For Thursday the freezing level will be at about 2000 m. Mostly, the snowpack will continue to be strong and well bonded with not breakable surface melt and re-freeze crusts. Everywhere there will be icy sections that can cause ruinous falls. Snowdrift deposits will be still significant at altitude, alternated with eroded areas. The possibility of avalanches triggering will continue to be low and limited to the areas under the ridge and along the steep slopes exposed to the far North and generally with high additional load. Natural avalanche activity is absent. The avalanche danger will be 1 (low) everywhere.
