


To the North, on the Alps, possible triggering caused by high additional load on extreme slopes.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: From the afternoon evening worsening with very slight snowfalls (2 cm). Expected avalanche danger is 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory. The snowpack is generally stable and has good firmness and is characterized on the surface by melt-and-freeze crusts, even very hard in the early morning, alternating with icy sections. On the sunny slopes, during the hot hours, the melt-and-freeze crusts tend to weaken superficially. On the northern slopes, at maximum altitudes below the thin melt-and-freeze crusts, there are wind deposits with good firmness and in the most shady areas, at the base of the snow cover, there are still basal layers with poor resistance but which have triggering difficulty. The probability of causing triggering is low, however, it cannot be excluded with high additional overload, in isolated areas on the northern and extreme slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 14 March 2019, reliability: 90%

To the North, on the Alps, possible triggering caused by high additional load on extreme slopes.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather in the morning, from the morning evening a new weak front can bring slight snowfalls (3-4 cm). Everywhere the snowpack is generally stable and has good firmness. Especially on the Northern slopes of the Alps, to maximum altitudes and on extreme slopes, the possibility of avalanches triggering with high additional overload can not be excluded on the isolated areas. Expected danger level is 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory. Possibility of presence of frozen sections is reported at all exposures, especially in the early morning.

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

Forecast for Friday 15 March 2019, reliability: 90%


To the North, on the Alps, possible triggering caused by high additional load on extreme slopes.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: From little cloudy to variable skies with increase in temperatures compared to previous days. Possibility of local precipitations on the Alps. The slight snowfalls during Thursday night are not affecting the avalanche danger that continues to be 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory. The snowpack is generally stable everywhere and has good firmness nevertheless, to the North exposures, to the maximum altitudes and on the extreme slopes, especially on the Alps, is not excluded the possibility to cause avalanches triggering on isolated areas with high additional load. Expected danger level is 1 (low) throughout the mountain area.

Forecast for Saturday 16 March 2019, reliability: 90%

To the North, on the Alps, possible triggering caused by high additional load on extreme slopes.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Expected variable sky with further increase in temperatures with average thermal zero at 2700 m. The snowpack is generally stable everywhere and has good firmness. Especially on the Northern slopes of the Alps, to maximum altitudes and on extreme slopes, is not excluded the possibility to cause avalanches triggering on isolated areas with high additional load. On the Southern slopes of the Alps, during the hottest hours, some local triggering from the walls is possible. Expected danger level is 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory.
