




Situation of 03 April 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 05-04-2019 hours 14, forecaster: DM

# Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:


Overcast skies, possible moderate rainfalls from the afternoon, snowfalls above 1500 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: From today's afternoon, new rainfalls are coming, snowfalls only above about 1400 m. The quantities will still be small, 5-10 cm. The avalanche danger on the territory is 1 (low) everywhere. The possibility of both natural and caused avalanches is extremely low as the snowpack is mainly stable and well bonded.

### Forecast for Thursday 04 April 2019, reliability: 70%

#### Increase in danger from the afternoon due to heavy snowfalls at altitude.

#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Heavy precipitations, very heavy on the Carnic Pre-Alps, especially towards evening. Heavy snow above 1500-1700 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Heavy rainfalls are expected on Thursday, very heavy from the afternoon, snowfalls only above about 1700 m, together with strong Southern winds. Precipitation will concentrate more on the Western Carnic Alps and Pre-Alps. A meter of snow may fall above 2000 m. The avalanche danger will be present mainly at altitude, above 1500-1700 m, as the hours go by and the accumulation of snow on the ground the danger will progressively increase. From the evening there will be the possibility of natural avalanches triggering of medium and large size along the usual avalanche places. Above 1800 m it will also be possible to cause triggering even with low additional load from steep slopes to all exposures and heavily loaded by wind. Expected danger level: 2 (moderate) in the morning, increasing to 3 (considerable) from the afternoon.








### Forecast for Friday 05 April 2019, reliability: 60%

#### Strong danger throughout the territory due to a lot of not bonded snow at altitude.


# Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

From heavy to very heavy precipitations at night. Snow altitude is decreasing to 1000m. Improvement in the afternoon.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** On Friday's day, further rainfalls are expected, with decreasing temperatures and snow altitude at 1000 m, a total of 50 cm of snow may fall at 1800 m. Given the consistent amount of new snow on the ground, it will be possible natural avalanches triggering of medium and large dimensions above 1700 m from the usual avalanche routes to all the exposures, even ground avalanche from the steepest grassy slopes. Always above 1700 m and to all exposures, to cause triggering of both loose snow and slab avalanches will be possible even with low additional load. Expected danger level is 4 (high) throughout the mountain territory.

### Forecast for Saturday 06 April 2019, reliability: 60%

#### Strong danger throughout the territory due to a lot of not bonded snow at altitude.

# **Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:** From cloudy to variable skies but no

From cloudy to variable skies but no rainfalls. Slight increase in temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: For Saturday the precipitations will cease but the snowpack will still be very unstable. Over 1700 m, natural avalanches of medium and large sizes will still be possible from the slopes not yet discharged to all exposures. The solar radiation, where present, will favor a strong natural avalanche activity, in particular to the Southern exposures and during the hottest hours. Ground avalanches will also be possible from the grassy slopes. To cause triggering of both loose snow and slab avalanches, of medium and large sizes, will be possible even with low additional load to all exposures from the steep and mainly wind-drifted slopes. Expected danger level is 4 (high) throughout the mountain territory.
