




Situation of 08 April 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 10-04-2019 hours 14, forecaster: DM


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy or overcast sky with generally weak rains. Snow altitude above 1500-1700 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Today new weak rainfalls are expected, snowy only above 1700 m, without significant consequences on the avalanche danger that will be 2 (moderate) everywhere, except for the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps where it will be 1 (low) for the little snow present. The natural avalanche activity will be limited to triggering and small avalanches from extremely steep slopes and rocky crags. Above 1800 m, during hottest hours, it will be possible to cause small surface avalanches triggering of moist or wet snow when passing with skis.

Forecast for Tuesday 09 April 2019, reliability: 80%

Moderately bonded snow cover everywhere, less danger on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Cloudy sky, possible weak rainfalls from the afternoon, snowy above 1800 m only.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: For Tuesday slight increase in temperatures and there will be the possibility of some weak rainfalls, snowy above 1800 m. only. Avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) everywhere, except for the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps where it will be 1 (low) for the little snow present. Above 1800 m, during hottest hours, it will be possible to cause small surface avalanches triggering of moist or wet snow when passing with skis. Always above such altitude, the natural avalanche activity will be limited to some loose snow avalanches od small/medium size from very steep slopes.









Forecast for Wednesday 10 April 2019, reliability: 80%

New moderate rainfalls are coming, snowy above 1800 m.








Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: New weak/moderate rainfalls are expected on Wednesday, snowy above about 1800 m, 10-15 cm of new snow are expected. Avalanche danger will still be 2 (moderate) everywhere, except for the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps where it will be 1 (low) for the little snow present. Only small and medium snow/loose snow avalanches will be possible above 1800 m from very steep slopes. Always above such altitude, it will be possible to cause limited triggering of loose snow when passing with skis.

Forecast for Thursday 11 April 2019, reliability: 80%

Moderately bonded snowpack everywhere, less danger on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Scattered rainfalls, snowy above about 1400, decrease in temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Thursday we will still have disturbed weather with possible weak rainfalls, snowy above about 1400-1600 m, with decrease in temperatures. Avalanche danger will still be 2 (moderate) everywhere, except for the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps where it will be 1 (low) for the little snow present. Only triggering from very steep slopes will be possible above 1800 m. Always above such altitude, the human triggering will be limited to small and medium triggering of loose snow by passage with skis.
