










Cloudy skies with probable scattered, weak or moderate rainfalls. Snow altitude above about 1800 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During last days there have been some disturbed impulses that have brought modest amounts of snow above 1800 m only, under such altitude it has rained. The snowpack up to 1800 m is mostly moist or wet, above such altitude modest quantities of new snow cover melt-and-freeze crusts, not breakable only at high altitudes. Above 1800 m there is the possibility of small loose natural avalanches from the steepest usual avalanche routes at all aspects. The human triggering of small superface loose avalanches can occur on steep slopes when passing with skis. On the central Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps the danger is minor due to the little snow present. Danger level: 2 (moderate) on the Carnic Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps, and Julian Alps, 1 (low) on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Forecast for Thursday 11 April 2019, reliability: 80%

Expected rainfalls, snowy above about 1200 m, avalanche danger mostly moderate.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

At night and morning widespread rainfalls, generally moderate, snowy above 1700 m, lowering down to 1200 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Between Wednesday night and Thursday morning new rainfalls are expected, snowy initially above 1700 m, lowering down to about 1200 m, with quantities of about 20-30 cm. On the Carnic Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps the danger will be 2 (moderate). Above 1800 m there is the possibility of small loose natural avalanches from the steepest usual avalanche routes at all aspects. Always above such altitude and from the steepest slopes, it will also be possible to cause small and medium avalanches even with low additional load. On the central Carnic Pre-Alps and on the Julian Pre-Alps the danger will be 1 (low) due to the smaller amount of snow present.








Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Mostly cloudy skies. Possible weak local and intermittent rainfalls, snowy above about

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Also for Friday the steady rainfalls will continue, snowy above 1200 m, which will not affect the current danger situation. On the Carnic Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps the danger will be 2 (moderate). Above 1800 m there is the possibility of small loose natural avalanches from the steepest usual avalanche routes at all aspects. Always above such altitude and from the steepest slopes, it will also be possible to cause small and medium avalanches even with low additional load. On the central Carnic Pre-Alps and on the Julian Pre-Alps the danger will be 1 (low) due to the smaller amount of snow present.

Forecast for Saturday 13 April 2019, reliability: 80%

Moderately bonded snowpack everywhere, minor danger on the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy with possibility of some weak rainfalls, snowy above about 1200 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Saturday the sky will be variable and weak scattered weak rainfalls will be possible, snowy above about 1200 m. The danger will be 2 (moderate) everywhere, except for the Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps where it will be 1 (low) due to the little snow present. Above 1800 m there is the possibility of small and medium loose natural avalanches from the usual avalanche routes very steep at all aspects. Always above such altitude and from the steepest slopes, passing with the skis, it will be possible to cause loose snow triggering.
