

Situation of 15 April 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 15-04-2019 hours 14, forecaster: MM



Possible loose snow natural avalanches above 1800 m.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During last days the mountain territory has been affected by several disturbed events which in some areas have brought fresh snow up to 1000 m. The quantities were very small, thicknesses of 10-20 cm were reached only over 1800 -2000 m. The snowpack is generally well bonded, even if, in particular under the highest ridges and passes, deposits of wind-drift snow can be found.Small loose snow natural avalanches are possible above 1800 m from the steepest slopes at all exposures. On the steep slopes of all sides, above 2000 m, the human triggering of surface small and medium avalanches is not excluded when passing with the skis. Minor danger on central Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps due to the almost absence of snow. Danger level expected: 2 (moderate) on Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps, 1 (low) on Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Forecast for Tuesday 16 April 2019, reliability: 80% **Possible loose snow natural avalanches above 1800 m**.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies with thermal zero at 1800 m. The snowpack is generally well bonded, even if, in particular under the highest ridges and passes, deposits of wind-drift snow can be found. Small loose snow natural avalanches are possible above 1800 m from the steepest slopes at all exposures. Above 2000 m, the human triggering of small and medium surface avalanches can not be excluded on the steep slopes at all sides when passing with skis. Danger will be minor on central Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps due to the almost absence of snow. Danger level expected: 2 (moderate) on Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps, 1 (low) on Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.




Forecast for Wednesday 17 April 2019, reliability: 70% Possible small natural and human avalanches triggering during hottest hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Little cloudy skies with slight increase in thermal zero up to 2300 m in the afternoon. The snowpack in the morning will be well bonded, in the hottest hours of the day, small natural triggering will be possible above 1800 m from the steepest slopes exposed to the sun, particularly near the rocks. Always in the hottest hours, on the areas of wind-drift snow deposits located above 2000 m, the human triggering of natural small and medium surface avalanches can not be excluded on the steep slopes at all sides when passing with skis. Danger will be minor on central Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps due to the almost absence of snow. Danger level expected: 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) on Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps, 1 (low) on Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.

Forecast for Thursday 18 April 2019, reliability: 70%

Possible small natural and human avalanches triggering during hottest hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies and thermal zero still at 2000 m. The snowpack in the morning will be well bonded, in the hottest hours of the day, small natural triggering will be possible above 1800 m from the steepest slopes and exposed to the sun, particularly near the rocks. Always in the hottest hours, on the areas of wind-drift snow deposits located above 2000 m, the human triggering of natural small and medium surface avalanches can not be excluded on the steep slopes at all sides when passing with skis. Danger will be minor on central Carnic and Julian Pre-Alps due to the almost absence of snow. Danger level expected: 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) on Alps, Western Carnic Pre-Alps and Julian Alps, 1 (low) on Julian and Carnic Pre-Alps.
