









#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:


Overcast with weak scattered rainfalls more continuous and widespread from the evening. Snow altitude around 1600m.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** In the afternoon overcast sky with weak and scattered rainfalls, more widespread from the evening, snowy above about 1500 m. On the Alps and on the Western Carnic Pre-Alps the danger is 2 (moderate): above 2200 m on very steep slopes with the presence of wind deposits, and mainly on the Northern slopes, the human triggering of slab avalanches, generally of medium size, is possible especially with high additional load. Wet snow natural avalanches of small and locally of medium size are also possible, on steep slopes from all sides, especially below 2200 m. On the Julian and Eastern Carnic Pre-Alps the danger is 1 (low). Small natural avalanches of wet snow and locally isolated small human triggering at skis passage are possible on very steep slopes still snow-covered.

## Forecast for Thursday 09 May 2019, reliability: 60%

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Overcast with moderate to heavy rains.

T.average 1000: 7 °C

T.average 2000: 0 °C

Snow above about 1500 m. More stable weather from the evening.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast with moderate to heavy rainfalls, snowy above about 1600 m. Expected 50-60 cm of new snow at 1800 m on the Canin, 20-30 cm elsewhere. Expected danger on Canin is 3 (considerable): natural avalanches of fresh snow will be possible above 1700-1800 m, medium and in some cases large, along the usual routes at all aspects and the human triggered avalanches on steep slopes will be possible with low additional load. On the Julian and Carnic Alps and on the Pre-Alps the danger will be 2 (moderate) above 1800 m it will be possible to have natural avalanches of fresh snow, of small and medium size, from the steep slopes at all sides. The human triggered avalanches, generally of medium size, will be possible especially with high additional load, but low additional load is not excluded locally on steep slopes.









# Forecast for Friday 10 May 2019, reliability: 60%

#### Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of large size from Canin.










Thermal Zero: 2500 m T.average 1000: 9 °C T.average 2000: 3 °C

#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable with scattered showers and some thunderstorms more likely on the Pre-Alps. Increase in temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Expected variability with showers in the afternoon. Increase in temperatures. Expected danger on Canin is 3 (considerable): natural avalanches of wet or moist snow will be possible above 1700-1800 m of medium and in some cases large size, along the usual routes at all aspects and the human triggered avalanches on steep slopes will be possible with low additional load. On the Alps and the Western Carnic Pre-Alps the danger will be 2 (moderate): above 1800 m it will be possible to have natural avalanches of wet or moist snow, of small and locally of medium size, from the steep slopes at all sides. The human triggered avalanches, generally of medium size, will be possible at the skis passage. Small natural avalanches of wet snow will be possible on very steep slopes still snow-covered and locally isolated small human triggering at the skis passage.

## Forecast for Saturday 11 May 2019, reliability: 70%

### Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of medium size locally.







Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable skies on the mountains with the possibility of local showers and thunderstorms in the afternoon

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast skies with moderate rainfalls from the afternoon. Thermal zero at 2500 m. On the Alps and on the Western Carnic Pre-Alps danger is 2 (moderate): natural avalanches of wet or moist snow, of small and locally of medium size, will be possible above 1800 m from steep slopes at all sides and the human triggered avalanche, generally of medium size, it will be possible at the skis passage. On the Julian and Eastern Carnic Pre-Alps, danger is 1 (low). On very steep slopes still snow-covered there will be the possibility of small natural avalanches of wet snow and locally isolated small human triggering at the skis passage.
