




Situation of 10 May 2019 edition of the hours 14-next update 13-05-2019 hours 14, forecaster: GA


Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of medium size locally.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Yesterday, from 10 to 15 cm of new snow fell above 1800 m. Today's afternoon variable sky is expected with the possibility of local showers and thunderstorms, and increase in temperatures. On the Alps and Canin the danger is 2 (moderate): above 1800 m, natural avalanches of small and locally of medium size of wet or moist snow are possible, on steep slopes at all aspects. The human triggered avalanches, generally of medium size, is possible at skis passage. On the Pre-Alps the danger is 1 (low): on very steep slopes still snow-covered, small natural avalanches of wet snow are possible and locally small human triggering by the skis passage.

Forecast for Saturday 11 May 2019, reliability: 80%

Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of medium size locally.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast skies with moderate rainfalls in the afternoon, more abundant in the evening. Increase in maximum temperatures. On the Alps and Canin the danger is 2 (moderate): since late morning, above 1800 m, natural avalanches of small and locally of medium size of wet or moist snow are possible, on steep slopes at all aspects. The human triggering of generally medium size avalanches, on deposit areas located at the maximum altitudes and on very steep slopes, it will be possible in the morning with high additional load. With the increase in daytime temperatures and the weakening of the surface layer of the snowpack, it will become possible even with the skis passage. On Pre-Alps the danger will be 1 (low): on very steep slopes still snow-covered small natural avalanches of wet snow and locally isolated small human triggering will be possible by the skis passage.



Forecast for Sunday 12 May 2019, reliability: 60%


Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of large size locally.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Abundant rainfalls during the night, even thunderstorms, snowy above about 1800 m. Expected 20-40 cm of new snow above 2000 m with peaks of 50 cm on the Canin. On the Alps and Canin the danger will be 2 (moderate): Above 1800 m on steep slopes and at all aspects natural fresh snow avalanches of small and medium size will be possible. On the Canin at highest altitudes, isolated large avalanches will be possible. The human triggered avalanches, mainly of small and medium size, will generally be possible with high additional load on deposit areas above 2000 m. On steep slopes, the low additional load is not excluded locally, particularly on the Canin. On Pre-Alps, the danger will be 1 (low): on very steep slopes at the highest altitudes, small natural avalanches of fresh snow and small human triggering by skis passage will be possible.

Forecast for Monday 13 May 2019, reliability: 60%

Possible both natural and human triggered avalanches, even of medium size locally.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast skies with possible weak scattered rainfalls, snowy above 1800 m. On the Alps and Canin the danger will be 2 (moderate): Above 1800 m on steep slopes and at all aspects natural fresh snow avalanches of small and medium size will be possible. The human triggered avalanches, mainly of small and medium size, will generally be possible with high additional load on deposit areas above 2000 m. On steep slopes, the low additional load is not excluded locally, particularly on the Canin. On Pre-Alps, the danger will be 1 (low): on very steep slopes at the highest altitudes, small natural avalanches of fresh snow and small human triggering by skis passage will be possible.
