





Situation of 03 February 2020 edition of the hours 14-next update 05-02-2020 hours 14, forecaster: MM


Little cloudy skies on the Alps, cloudy on the Prealps due to low clouds.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies on the Prealps due to low clouds, little cloudy skies on the Alps with really high temperatures during this period at altitude. On the Alps and Canin area the danger is 2 (moderate):during hot hours, generally small natural avalanches triggering will be possible from the walls and along the steepest slopes, mostly on sunny slopes. On steep slopes, generally on the northern slopes above 1900 m the human slab triggering may still occur with high additional load in wind-drifted deposit areas. On the Canin area triggering can be even larger in size. On the Prealps the danger is 1 (low): during hot hours and at maximum altitudes small natural triggering from steeper slopes and small human triggering on the steep slopes in the northern exposures are possible with high additional load.

Forecast for Tuesday 04 February 2020, reliability: 70%

Human triggered avalanches are possible on the Alps, mainly with high additional load.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

In the morning light snowfall (5-10 cm), then improvement.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: In the morning, light rainfall is expected throughout the mountain range with temperatures lower than on previous days. The greatest amount of snow will be in the eastern areas with a maximum thickness of 10 cm. On the Alps and on the Canin area the danger will be 2 (moderate): in the areas with new and old wind-drifted snow deposits, generally located above 1900 m of the northern slopes, there is still the possibility of small human triggered slabs mainly with high additional load. On the Canin, and in any case in all areas where slab thicknesses are more consistent, triggering may be even larger in size. From the rocky walls and very steep slopes, small natural loose snow triggering will be possible. On the Prealps the danger will be 1 (low): at the highest altitudes small human triggering will be possible on the steep slopes in the northern aspects with high additional load.





Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy skies. Strong wind with gusts around 100 km/h.


Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Partly cloudy skies with further decrease in temperatures and strong northern wind with gusts over 100km/h. Strong wind chill effect. On then Alps and Canin area the danger will be 2 (moderate): in the areas with wind-drifted snow deposits, generally located above 1900 m of the northern slopes, there is still the possibility of small human triggered slabs mainly with high additional load. On the Canin area, and in any case in all areas where slab thicknesses are more consistent, triggering may be even larger in size. On the Prealps the danger will be 1 (low): at the highest altitudes small human triggering will be possible on the steep slopes in the northern aspects with high additional load. Everywhere, pay attention to the icy areas presence.

Forecast for Thursday 06 February 2020, reliability: 70%

Human triggered avalanches will be possible on the Alps, mainly with high additional low.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Little cloudy skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still cloudy skies with a northerly wind, but lower than on Wednesday. In the Alps and the Canin area the danger will be 2 (moderate):in the areas with wind-drifted snow deposits, generally located above 1900 m of the northern slopes, there is still the possibility of small human triggered slabs mainly with high additional load. On the Canin area, and in any case in all areas where slab thicknesses are more consistent, triggering may be even larger in size. On the Prealps the danger will be 1 (low): at the highest altitudes small human triggering will be possible on the steep slopes in the northern aspects with high additional load. Everywhere, pay attention to the icy areas presence..
