


Situation of 16 March 2020 edition of the hours 14-next update 18-03-2020 hours 14, forecaster: MD


Clear skies. From the afternoon rapid increase in temperatures at altitude. Freezing point at 2800 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: From the afternoon rapid increase in temperature at altitude. On the Alps, the avalanches danger is 2 (moderate): always from the afternoon small triggering are possible from the walls and along the gullies in all the aspects. Always in all the aspects on very steep slopes above 1800 m, the human triggering of small wet or mist snow avalanches is possible while skiing, in particular from the afternoon. On the Prealps, the danger is 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) from the afternoon: on very steep slopes in all the aspects, human triggering of small avalanches is possible above 1800 m while skiing; furthermore, during the hottest hours small natural triggering are possible in the sunniest areas.

Forecast for Tuesday 17 March 2020, reliability: 80%

Both natural and human triggered avalanches are possible due to thermal increase.


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Little cloudy to variable skies for even thick glazing. Mild temperatures at altitude.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Partly cloudy or glazed skies, this will favor the weakening of the surface layers of the snowpack from late morning onwards already. The avalanches danger will be 2 (moderate) all over the mountain territory. During hottest hours, both small and medium natural avalanches will be possible from the very steep slopes in all the aspects but from the sunny ones in particular. Always from late morning human triggering of small and medium wet or moist snow avalanches will be possible while skiing.

Forecast for Wednesday 18 March 2020, reliability: 80%

Both natural and human triggered avalanches are possible during hottest hours.


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear or little cloudy skies, thermal inversion in the valleys at night. Possible some local fog bank.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather with freezing point at 2500 m. The avalanches danger will be 1 (low) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning all over the mountain territory. Always from late morning above 1800 m, wet or moist loose snow avalanches, small and medium in size, will be possible from the sunny steepest slopes. During the hottest hours of the day, always above 1800 m, the human triggered avalanches of small and medium wet or moist snow can occur while skiing in sunny aspects in particular.

Forecast for Thursday 19 March 2020, reliability: 80%

Both natural and human triggered avalanches are possible during hottest hours.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear to cloudy with breezy winds. Fairly mild daytime temperatures in inland areas.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The expected weather conditions will not change the avalanche danger condition which will continue to be 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) during the hottest hours of the day. Above 1800 m possible triggering and small natural avalanches will still be possible from sunny slopes during the hottest hours. Beyond this altitude, the human triggering of small loose snow avalanches of wet or moist snow may occur while skiing, especially while skiing in the sunny aspects.
