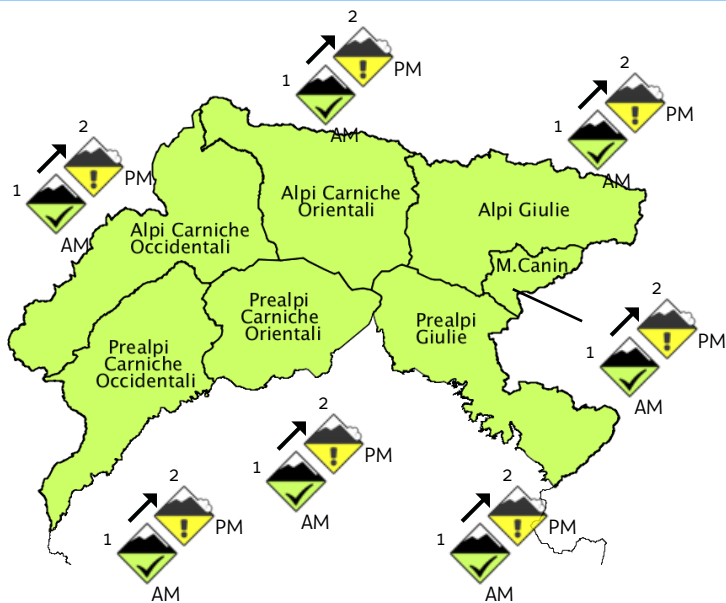

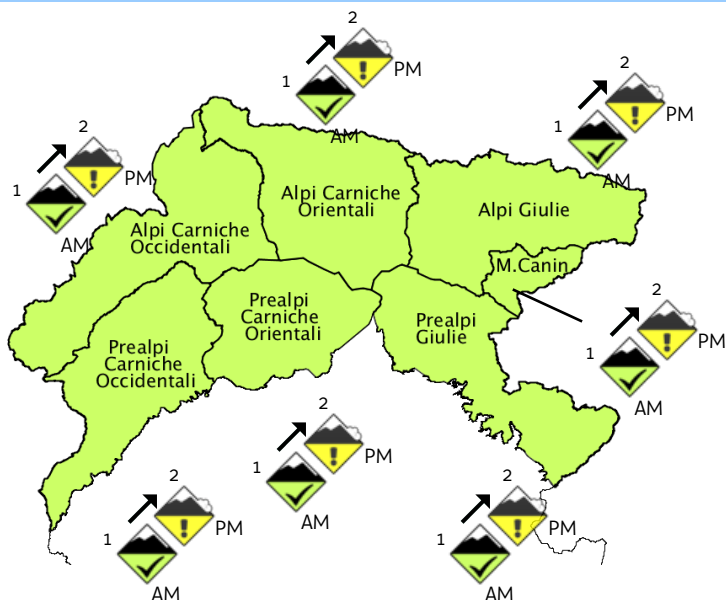

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather with clear skies. The snowpack in the morning is generally stable and well bounded due to the nighttime freezing of the surface layer. Starting late morning above 1800 m, natural avalanche activity is starting again with wet or moist snow avalanches, generally of loose snow and small in size, even ground avalanches on grassy slopes and screes with little snow. On the Alpine belt where the snowpack thicknesses are more consistent, even medium-sized triggering are not excluded, especially on sunny slopes. Also from late morning, human triggering of small avalanches, usually superficial, can occur while skiing. The danger level: 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning all over the mountain territory.

Forecast for Tuesday 07 April 2020, reliability: 80%

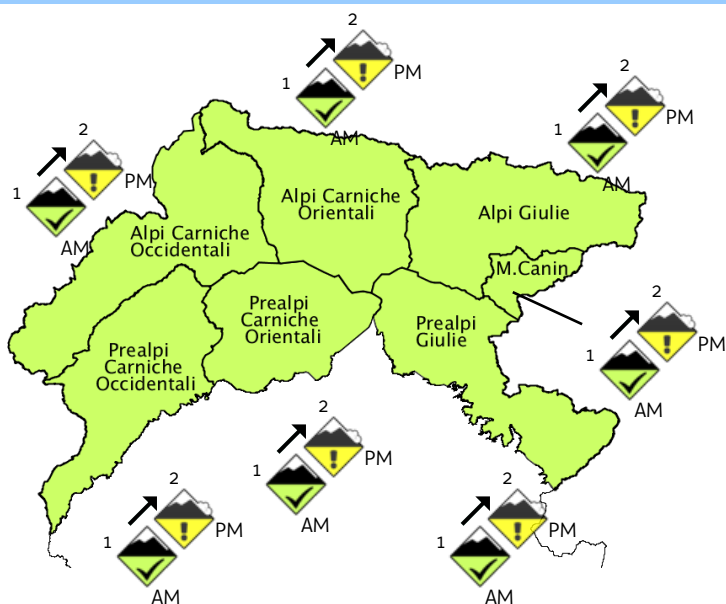

Clear skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies. The snowpack in the morning will be generally stable and well bounded. Starting late morning above 1800 m, natural avalanche activity will be starting again with wet or moist snow avalanches, generally of loose snow and small in size, even ground avalanches on grassy slopes and screes with little snow. On the Alpine belt where the snowpack thicknesses are more consistent, even medium-sized triggering are not excluded, especially on sunny slopes. Also from late morning, human triggering of small avalanches, usually superficial, could occur while skiing. The expected danger level: 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning all over the mountain territory.

Forecast for Wednesday 08 April 2020, reliability: 70%

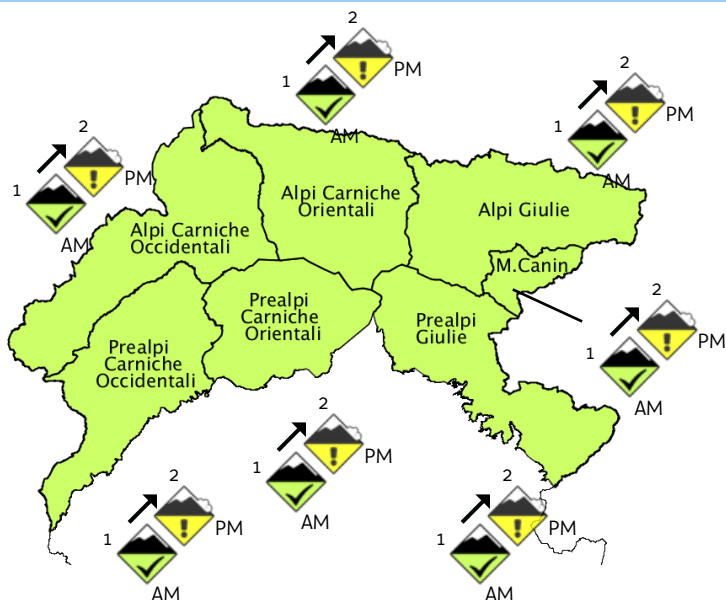

On the Alpine belt where the snowpack thicknesses are more consistent, even medium-sized triggering are not excluded, especially on sunny slopes.
