








Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Mainly little cloudy skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies. In the morning the snowpack is generally stable and well bounded. With the significant increase in daytime temperatures, the surface layers of the snowpack tend to melt. The avalanches danger level is 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning throughout the mountain area. Natural surface avalanches of wet or moist snow are possible on steep and very steep slopes. The phenomena on the Alps will affect all aspects starting from the East to the North, particularly below 2100 m. On the Pre-Alps, the phenomena will instead affect only the northern slopes where snow is still present. Everywhere, still during hot hours, the small and medium human triggered avalanches can occur even with low additional load.

Forecast for Saturday 11 April 2020, reliability: 80%

Natural avalanches, small and medium in size, during hot hours.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear or little cloudy skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Still good weather with little cloudy skies. Expected avalanches danger: 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) frm late morning all over the mountain territory. With the daytime increase in temperatures, the surface layers of the snowpack will tend to weaken, thus favoring natural small and medium surface avalanches of wet and moist snow on steep and very steep slopes. The phenomena on the Alps will affect all aspects starting from the East to the North, particularly below 2100 m. On the Pre-Alps, the phenomena will instead affect only the northern slopes. Everywhere, still during hot hours, the small and medium human triggered avalanches could occur even with low additional load.















Forecast for Sunday 12 April 2020, reliability: 80%


Natural avalanches, small and medium in size, during hot hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear or little cloudy skies with still high daytime temperatures. In the morning the avalanches danger will be: 1 (low) and will tend to increase to 2 (moderate) from late morning all over the mountain territory. Natural small and medium surface avalanches of wet and moist snow on steep and very steep slopes will be possible. The phenomena on the Alps will affect all aspects starting from the East to the North. On the Pre-Alps, the phenomena will instead affect only the northern slopes. Everywhere, still during hot hours, the small and medium human triggered avalanches could occur even with low additional load.

Forecast for Monday 13 April 2020, reliability: 70%

Natural avalanches, small and medium in size, during hot hours.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: More variability and increase in cloudiness from the afternoon. During hottest hours of the day on the steep slopes there will be possible surface avalanches of wet and moist snow, small and medium in size. The phenomena on the Alps will affect all aspects starting from the East to the North. On the Pre-Alps, the phenomena will instead affect only the northern slopes. Everywhere, still during hot hours, the small and medium human triggered avalanches could occur even with low additional load. Expected danger level 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) during hot hours.



















Forecast for Tuesday 14 April 2020, reliability: 60%

Weather worsening with possible light new snowfall.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Until the early morning a fast front will affect our region with generally light rainfall with decrease in temperatures. 5 cm od new snow are expected above 1500 m. Danger level 1 (low) with possible increase to 2 (moderate) in relation to the amount of new snow expected and the possibility of more sunshine in the afternoon. From the walls and along steeper slopes, discharges and small loose avalanches of new snow will be possible in all aspects but especially on sunny slopes. The human triggering of small avalanches in general could occur mainly with high additional load.
