









Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear or cloudy skies for the transit of some glazing.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Although temperatures are now very mild even at high altitudes, the snowpack is stable and well bounded everywhere with load-bearing surface crusts in the early hours of the day. On the Alps, the avalanche danger in the morning is 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning. Above 1800 m, small and medium natural surface avalanches of wet or moit snow from steep and very steep slopes exposed mainly to the South and to the East are possible. Still above 1800 m and during the hottest hours, the human triggering of small avalanches of wet or moist snow can occur even with light additional load at all aspects. On the Prealps, the avalanche danger is 1 (low) as snow is now almost exclusively present to the North.

Forecast for Saturday 18 April 2020, reliability: 90%

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Little cloudy or variable. Some local rain showers are possible in the afternoon on the Alps. Breeze winds.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Saturday, on the Alps, local and sporadic afternoon thunderstorms will be possible along the border ridge with snow only on the highest peaks and in any case without affecting the stability of the snowpack. On the Alps, the avalanche danger in the morning will be 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning. Above 1800 m there will be the possibility of small and medium natural surface avalanches of wet or moist snow from steep and very steep slopes exposed mainly to the South and to the East. Still above 1800 m and during the hottest hours, the human triggering of small avalanches of wet or moist snow could occur even with light additional load at all aspects. On the Prealps, the avalanche danger will be 1 (low) as snow is now almost exclusively present to the North.















Danger increasing to moderate from late morning due to surface layers weakness







Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Generally variable skies. Some local rain shower or thunderstorm will be possible from afternoon-evening.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Sunday, local and sporadic afternoon thunderstorms will be possible on the Alps with snow above about 2400 m and in any case without affecting the stability of the snowpack. On the Alps, the avalanche danger in the morning will be 1 (low) increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning. Above 1800 m there will be the possibility of small and medium natural surface avalanches of wet or moist snow from steep and very steep slopes exposed mainly to the South and to the East.Still above 1800 m and during the hottest hours, the human triggering of small avalanches of wet or moist snow could occur even with light additional load at all aspects. On the Prealps, the avalanche danger will be 1 (low) as snow is now almost exclusively present to the North.

Forecast for Monday 20 April 2020, reliability: 90%

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy to variable skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Monday there will be cloudy to variable skies. Avalanches danger will be 1 (low) all over the mountain territory due to decrease in temperatures. Triggering and small atural surface avalanches of wet or moist snow will be possible above 1800 m from steep and very steep slopes exposed mainly to the South and to the East. The human triggering will be very unlikely everywhere as the snowpack will be stable and well bounded everywhere.
