






Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is stable and well bounded everywhere despite the skies cloudiness, this due to the ongoing thermal decrease. Avalanches danger is 1 (low) all over the whole mountain territory. On the Alps, in the afternoon, sluffs and small avalanches are possible on very steep slopes in all aspects, particularly below 2100 m of altitude. On the Pre-Alpine belt, snow is only present in the Northern aspects. During hot hours, at the highest altitudes and on extreme slopes, sluffs of wet or moist snow are possible. Everywhere, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches small-in size of wet or moist snow can occur locally even with a low additional load.

Forecast for Tuesday 21 April 2020, reliability: 90%

Small natural avalanches are possible in the afternoon due to the surface layers weakness.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Little cloudy skies expected with static temperatures. The avalanches danger will be 1 (low) all over the whole mountain territory. On the Alps, in the afternoon, sluffs and small avalanches will be possible on very steep slopes in all aspects, particularly below 2200 m of altitude. On the Pre-Alps, still during hot hours and in the Northern aspects where the snow is still present, sluffs of wet or moist snow will be possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. Everywhere, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches small-in size of wet or moist snow could occur locally even with a low additional load.






Forecast for Wednesday 22 April 2020, reliability: 90% Small natural avalanches of wet snow are possible in the afternoon.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear or little cloudy skies expected with slight decrease in temperatures. The avalanches danger will be 1 (low) all over the whole mountain territory. On the Alps, sluffs will be possible on very steep slopes during the hot hours in all aspects, particularly below 2000-2100 m of altitude. On the Pre-Alps, still during hot hours and in the Northern aspects where the snow is still present, sluffs of wet or moist snow will be possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. Everywhere, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches small-in size of wet or moist snow could occur locally even with a low additional load.

Forecast for Thursday 23 April 2020, reliability: 80% Small natural avalanches of wet snow are possible in the afternoon.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies expected, with freezing point at 2400 m. The avalanches danger will be 1 (low) all over the whole mountain territory. On the Alps, sluffs will be possible on very steep slopes during the hot hours in all aspects, particularly below 2100 m of altitude. On the Pre-Alps, still during hot hours and in the Northern aspects where the snow is still present, sluffs of wet or moist snow will be possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. Everywhere, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches small-in size of wet or moist snow could occur locally even with a low additional load.
