







Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is generally stable and well bounded everywhere. With the daytime increase in temperature, the surface layer of the snowpack has a tendency to melt, favoring the local renewal of typical springtime avalanches. The avalanches danger is 1 (low) all over the whole mountain territory. On the Alps, in the afternoon, sluffs and small avalanches are possible on very steep slopes in all aspects, particularly below 2100 m of altitude. On the Prealps, still during hot hours and in the Northern aspects where snow is still present, sluffs of wet and moist snow are possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. All over the whole mountain territory, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches, small-in size of wet or moist snow, can occur locally even with a low additional load.

Forecast for Thursday 23 April 2020, reliability: 90%

Natural wet snow avalanches are possible from late morning.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Clear or little cloudy skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear or little cloudy skies is expected. On the Alps, the avalanches danger will be 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) starting late morning. Natural avalanches, generally small in size will be possible during hot hours from the very steep slopes. The most likely altitudes for triggering will be those between 1800 and 2200 m. On the Prealps the avalanches danger will be 1 (low):still during hot hours and in the aspects to the North wet or moist snow sluffs will be possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. All over the whole mountain territory, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches, small-in size of wet or moist snow, could occur locally even with a low additional load.











On the Alps, the avalanches danger will be 1 (low) in the morning increasing to 2 (moderate) starting late morning. During the hot hours, on the very steep slopes above 1800-2000 m and in all exposures, small and locally also medium-sized natural avalanches will be possible on the Eastern and Northern slopes. On the Prealps the avalanches danger will be 1 (low): still during hot hours and in the aspects to the North wet or moist snow sluffs will be possible from the extreme slopes at the highest altitudes. All over the whole mountain territory, still during the hot hours and on steep slopes, the human triggered avalanches, small-in size of wet or moist snow, could occur locally even with a low additional load.
