




Situation of 24 December 2020 edition of the hours 14-next update 28-12-2020 hours 14, forecaster: AM


reliability: 80%

Danger 1 (low), increasing to 2 (moderate) due to new snowfall.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies with light or moderate snowfall. Initially, only above 1800 m, with snow decreasing from the afternoon to evening. Expected 5-10 cm in the west and 15-20 cm in the east. Starting in the afternoon, the danger level will reach 2 (moderate): small, spontaneous avalanches of dry snow are possible from mountain sides and along the gullies at high altitudes, especially in the Julian and Canin Alps. The triggering of small avalanches in accumulation areas may also occur when single skiers-hikers pass. Below 1700 m, small and local medium-sized wet snow avalanches on plains are possible.

Forecast for Friday 25 December 2020, reliability: 70% Increased danger due to new snow with wind.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: New snowfall above 500 m. 15-20 cm of snow may fall at 1500 m. New snow might not bind with old snowpack because of compactsurfaces. The wind will also favor the formation of new accumulations at all exposures. On the Julian and Canin Alps, the danger level will reach 3 (considerable): natural avalanches will be possible along the slopes and leeward gullies, even medium- sized and triggering, always medium-sized, may occur in accumulation areas even with low overload. In the Carnic Alps and in the Pre-Alps, the danger will be 2 (moderate): possible small avalanches from the slopes and along the steep gullies. The detachment of small surface slabs may also occur with low overload. Beware of icy sections.




Forecast for Saturday 26 December 2020, reliability: 70%

Danger of both spontaneous and triggered avalanches even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies with sharply falling temperatures and sustained NE winds at high altitudes. Wind accumulations on steep slopes will be easily detachable everywhere. On the Julian and Canin Alps, the danger level will reach 3 (considerable): beyond the tree line, possibility of slabs detaching, even of medium size, when skiers-hikers pass. Natural release avalanches may also occur both with loose cohesion and slabs from slopes and along leeward gullies, even small- and medium-sized. In the Carnic Alps and in the Pre-Alps, the danger will be 2 (moderate): possible small avalanches from the slopes and along the steep gullies. The detachment of small surface slabs may also occur with low overload. Beware of icy sections.

Forecast for Sunday 27 December 2020, reliability: 60% Danger of both spontaneous and triggered avalanches even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies starting at night, increased worsening conditions with new heavy snowfalls, initially also on plains and with strong southern winds. On the Julian and Canin Alps, the danger level will reach 3 (considerable): beyond the tree line, possibility of slabs detaching, even of medium size, when skiers-hikers pass. Natural release avalanches may also occur both with loose cohesion and slabs from slopes and along leeward gullies, even small- and medium-sized. In the Carnic Alps and in the Pre-Alps, the danger will be 2 (moderate): possible small avalanches from the slopes and along the steep gullies. The detachment of small surface slabs may also occur with low overload. Beware of icy sections.



Forecast for Monday 28 December 2020, reliability: 60% Avalanche danger 4 (high) due to heavy snowfall and stormy winds.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Heavy snow is expected with stormy winds. 80-90 cm of new snow could fall throughout the mountain area. Avalanche danger mayreach level 4 (high) across the entire territory in the morning. Spontaneous releases of both loose and slab avalanches may occur along the usual steep slopes, even below tree line, of medium and large size, at all exposures. Very large avalanches are also possible locally in the north. Avalanche phenomena may affect all stretches of the road system and areas subject to danger above 500 m. The triggering of even large avalanches on steep slopes may already occur; already low overload. Unfavorable conditions for excursions, maximum caution is required.
