


Overcast skies in the Prealps, improved weather in the Alps. Light rain or sleet in the Julian Prealps.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Snowpack tends to consolidate especially at medium altitudes and on southern slopes. In the Alps above1,800 m, avalanche danger is 3 (considerable) while, below this altitude and in the Prealps, avalanchedanger is 2 (moderate), possibly increasing to 3 (considerable) during warmer hours: in areas with wind-blown accumulations, at all exposures above 1,800 m, chance of triggered slab avalanches, generallymedium-sized, mainly with high overload. Low overload not excluded on steep slopes on the Alps andduring the warm hours also on the Prealps, with possible, even large-sized, avalanches. Also during warmerhours, especially at medium altitudes and at all exposures, small- and medium-sized natural avalanches arepossible along the usual steep slopes. On steep grassy slopes, especially on southern slopes, chance ofoccasional large slip avalanches.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Usually cloudy or variable skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies over the Alps, cloudy over the Prealps. In the Alps above 1,800 m, avalanche danger will be 3(considerable) while, below this altitude and in the Prealps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate), possiblyincreasing to 3 (considerable) during warmer hours: in areas with wind-blown accumulations at allexposures above 1,800 m, chance of triggered slab avalanches, generally medium-sized, mainly with highoverload. Low overload not excluded on steep slopes on the Alps and during the warm hours also on the Prealps, with possible, even large-sized, avalanches. Also during warmer hours, especially at mediumaltitudes and at all exposures, small- and medium-sized natural avalanches are possible along the usualsteep slopes. On steep grassy slopes, especially on southern slopes, chance of occasional large slipavalanches.








Forecast for Friday 05 February 2021, reliability: 60%

Chance of both natural and triggered avalanches, locally with low overload.











Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Variable cloudy skies in the Prealps, chance of light scattered showers.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Generally variable skies. In the Alps above 1,800 m, avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) while, belowthis altitude and in the Prealps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate), possibly increasing to 3(considerable) during warmer hours: in areas with windblown accumulations at all aspects above 1,800 m,chance of triggered slab avalanches, generally medium-sized, mainly with high overload. Low overload notexcluded on steep slopes on the Alps and during the warm hours also on the Prealps, with possible, even large-sized, avalanches. Also during warmer hours, especially at medium altitudes and at all exposures,small- and medium-sized natural avalanches are possible along the usual steep slopes. On steep grassyslopes, especially on southern slopes, chance of occasional large slip avalanches.

Forecast for Saturday 06 February 2021, reliability: 60%

Chance of both natural and triggered avalanches, locally with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: By Saturday, the freezing point and temperatures will rise at 3,000 m. In the Alps above 1,800 m, avalanchedanger will be 3 (considerable) while, below this altitude and in the Prealps,, avalanche danger will be 2(moderate), possibly increasing to 3 (considerable) during warmer hours: in areas with wind-blownaccumulations at all exposures beyond 1,800 m, chance of triggered slab avalanches, generally medium-sized, mainly with high overload. Low overload not excluded on steep slopes on the Alps and during thewarm hours also on the Prealps, with possible, even large-sized, avalanches. Also during warmer hours,especially at medium altitudes and at all exposures, small- and medium-sized natural avalanches arepossible along the usual steep slopes. On steep grassy slopes, especially on southern slopes, chance ofoccasional large slip avalanches.
