




Situation of 08 February 2021 edition of the hours 14-next update 10-02-2021 hours 14, forecaster: GA

## Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Generally moderate precipitation in the morning with snowfall above 800-1000 m, variable in the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Intense rainfall yesterday affected the Prealps and the Canin. More than 200 mm of rain fell in several areas. More than 1 meter of new snow fell on the Canin above 2000 m, 65 cm at 1800 m on the Gilberti. On the rest of the territory, 30 cm of new snow fell over 1800 m. On the Prealps and the Canin, avalanche danger is 4 (high), while on the Carnic and Julian Alps, it is 3 (considerable). On many steep slopes, medium and large natural avalanches are possible at all exposures, even very large in some cases on the Canin. Slip avalanches are also likely on grassy slopes, including large ones. Some phenomena can still affect roads and man-made areas subject to danger in the Canin area, at up to 500-600 m of altitude. Chance of triggered anywhere beyond the tree line, even with low overload. Unfavorable conditions for excursions.

#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Light to moderate rainfall at night and in the morning, snow above 800-1000 m. Cloudy

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: In the night and in the morning, weak snowfall is expected in the west, more consistent in the east, with snow at 800-1000 m. Cloudy. On the Canin, avalanche danger will be 4 (high), while it will be 3 (considerable) throughout the rest of the territory. On many steep not yet triggered slopes, medium and large natural avalanches will be possible at all exposures. In individual cases, even very large on the Canin. In accumulation areas above the tree line, chance of medium and large triggered avalanches in the Canin area, possible in other areas, and already with low overload. Slip avalanches on grassy slopes, even large ones, will still be possible. Some phenomena can still affect road, especially in the Canin area. Good local risk assessment skills will be required for excursions.

## Forecast for Wednesday 10 February 2021, reliability: 60%

#### Heavy to intense snowfall will bring avalanche danger to 4 (high) throughout the area.


## Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Cloudy with heavy snowfall, snow over 700-1000 m in the Alps, 1000-1300 m in the Prealps.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Heavy to intense snowfall is expected above 800-1000 m in the Alps and at higher altitudes in the Prealps. If the quantities of new snow are confirmed, avalanche danger will become 4 (high) in the course of day across the entire mountain territory. On many steep slopes, both superficial and ground natural avalanches will be likely on grassy slopes, large and, in some cases, even very large at all exposures. Some phenomena may affect roads and man-made areas, even below the snowline. In accumulation areas, at all exposures, even inside the woods, chance of medium and large triggered avalanches, even with low overload. Unfavorable conditions for excursions.

#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear or partly cloudy skies. Winds from the N at high altitudes, evening temperatures decreasing with the bora.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather is forecasted, with winds from the north at high altitudes, which will favor the formation of new accumulations at all exposures, but mainly on southern slopes. Avalanche danger will still be 4 (high) across the entire mountain territory. On steep not yet discharged slopes, particularly on sunny slopes, medium and large spontaneous avalanches will be possible at all exposures. Slip avalanches on grassy slopes are still possible, even of large ones. Some phenomena may still affect roads and man-made areas. In accumulation areas at all exposures, even inside the woodland, chance of medium and large triggered avalanches already with low overload.
