




Situation of 10 February 2021 edition of the hours 14-next update 12-02-2021 hours 14, forecaster: GA





**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** New snowfall on mountains. At 10 am, 10-15cm of new snow in the west, 30-40cm in the east, fell at 1800 m. Until the evening, more snow may the same areas. On the Canin, avalanche danger is 4 (high), and 3 (considerable) throughout the rest of the territory and, on many steep slopes, there is a likely chance that new snow and accumulations of wind-blown snow may detach moth spontaneously and with the passage of single skiers-hikers. Throughout the remaining territory, the above described conditions are still possible. Local medium to large surface avalanches could involve the deeper layers of the snowpack, becoming very large. On grassy slopes, mainly southern ones, even large slip avalanches are to be expected. Some phenomena may affect roads and manmade areas subject to danger, especially in the area of the Canin.

Forecast for Thursday 11 February 2021, reliability: 70%


Chance of both natural and triggered avalanches, even with low overload.



**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Cloudy skies with falling temperatures. At high altitudes, the forecasted NW winds will form new accumulations at all exposures. On Canin, avalanche danger will be 4 (high), and 3 (considerable) throughout the rest of the territory. On many, not yet discharged, steep slopes, medium or large natural avalanches are possible at all exposures and, in single cases, even very large ones on the Canin. In areas of accumulation above the tree line, the medium and large triggered avalanches are likely in the Canin area, and possible in other areas, even with low overload. Slip avalanches on grassy slopes, even large ones, are still possible. Some phenomena may still affect roads, especially in the Canin area. For excursions, great caution and maximum attention will be required in avoiding areas with wind-blown accumulations and those with cracks in the snowpack.

Forecast for Friday 12 February 2021, reliability: 70%



**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Clear or partly cloudy skies. Cold temperatures. Partially uncertain forecast.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Good weather expected. Avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) throughout the entire mountain territory. The sharp drop in temperatures may favor the formation of fragile layers below wind-blown accumulations, making them easily detachable. On many steep slopes, especially above the tree line, chance of avalanches in areas with wind-blown accumulations, also with the passage of single skiers-hikers. Avalanches could also locally become large or very large, affecting even deep layers of the snowpack, especially in the Canin area. Naturally triggered avalanche activity will be decreasing, with small- and medium-sized phenomena, while slip avalanches, also large ones, may still occur on grassy slopes. For excursions, great caution and maximum attention will be required in avoiding areas with wind-blown accumulations and those with cracks in the snowpack. Risk of slipping on ice.

**Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:**  
Clear or partly cloudy skies. Cold temperatures.

**Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger:** Good weather with sustained NE winds at high altitudes and very intense cold. Avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) throughout the entire mountain territory. Wind-blown accumulations present on steep slopes, especially above the tree line, can be easily detachable, also with the passage of single skiers-hikers. Avalanches could also be locally large or very large, especially in the Canin area. Generally small- and medium-sized natural avalanches will be possible along the lee slopes. Despite the cold, slip avalanches may still occur on southern grassy slopes, even large-sized. Great caution and maximum attention will be required in avoiding areas with wind-blown accumulations and those with cracks in the snowpack. Risk of slipping on ice. Unfavorable conditions for excursions due to the cold.
