
In the morning, clear or partly cloudy skies with haze. Extended frost during the night.Slightly rising temperatures.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Strong winds in recent days have led to the formation of new snow accumulations, whichcan be unstable, due to the presence of fragile inner layers. On the Alps, beyond the treeline, avalanche danger is 3 (considerable): at all exposures, triggered slabs are alsopossible with the passage of single skiers-hikers. These can be generally medium-sizedand, in some cases, they may be larger, especially in the Canin area. On the Prealps and Alps below the tree line, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate): triggered small- and medium-sized avalanches are possible, mainly with a strong overload, but also with weak,especially on steep slopes. Chance of small natural avalanches throughout, includingground avalanches and on steep grassy slopes. Careful attention should be given to thepresence of cracks in the snowpack and the presence of icy areas.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack will be moderately consolidated, due to the presence of unstable wind-blown accumulations. On the Alps beyond the tree line, avalanche danger will be 3(considerable): at all exposures, triggered slabs are also possible with the passage ofsingle skiers-hikers. These can be generally medium-sized and, in some cases, they maybe larger, especially in the Canin area. On the Prealps and Alps below the tree line, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate): triggered small- and medium-sized avalanches arepossible, mainly with a strong overload, but also with weak, especially on steep slopes. Chance of small natural avalanches throughout, especially near rocks on sunny slopes. The possibility of triggered ground avalanches on steep grassy slopes remains latent. Careful attention should be given to the presence of cracks in the snowpack and thepresence of icy areas.






















Forecast for Wednesday 17 February 2021, reliability: 70%

### Chance of both triggered avalanches, even with low overload, and slip avalanches.






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Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: In the morning, partly cloudy or variable skies, followed by improving weather.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack, especially at high altitudes, will be moderately consolidated, due to thepresence of unstable wind-blown accumulations. On the Alps beyond the tree line, avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable): ): at all exposures, triggered slabs are alsopossible with the passage of single skiers-hikers. These can be generally medium-sizedand, in some cases, they may be larger, especially in the Canin area. On the Prealps and Alps below the tree line, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate): triggered small- and medium-sized avalanches are possible, mainly with a strong overload, but also with weak, especially on steep slopes. Chance of small natural avalanches throughout, especiallynear rocks on sunny slopes. The possibility of triggered ground avalanches on steepgrassy slopes remains latent. Careful attention should be given to the presence of cracksin the snowpack and the presence of icy areas.
