






Clear or partly cloudy skies, moderate northern wind, especially at high altitudes.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear or partly cloudy skies with low temperatures. In the Alps, above the treeline, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate): winds at high altitudes have altered fresh snow. Thedanger is constituted by wind-drifted snow accumulations above the treeline. Hazardouspoints are located in basins, gullies, near ridges, and are more widespread at highestaltitudes and on northern slopes. These areas should be avoided, since they can creategenerally small avalanches if stressed, but also locally with the passage of single skiers-hikers, especially on steep slopes. Small natural avalanches are possible on very steepslopes. In the Pre-Alps and Alps below the treeline, avalanche danger is 1 (low). Chanceof small local avalanches on extreme slopes, mainly in the north, and isolated smallspontaneous avalanches on steep slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 18 March 2021, reliability: 80%

At high altitudes, locally unstable wind-drifted snow, especially on northern slopes.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear or partly cloudy skies. In the afternoon, weak snowfall above 500 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Continued good weather with low temperatures. Possible weak precipitation in theafternoon. On the Alps above the treeline, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) and willcontinue to be constituted by superficial accumulations of wind-drifted snow accumulations basins, gullies, and near the ridges. These deposits, which are more widespread athigher altitudes and on northern slopes, could cause generally small avalanches ifoverloaded, but also locally with the passage of single skiers-hikers, especially on steepslopes. Small natural avalanches are still possible on very steep slopes. In the Pre-Alpsand Alps below the treeline, avalanche danger will be 1 (low). Chance of small localavalanches on extreme slopes, mainly in the north, and isolated small spontaneous avalanches on steep slopes. Beware of the risk of slipping on icy areas or areas leveledout by wind.






















Forecast for Friday 19 March 2021, reliability: 70%

At high altitudes, locally unstable wind-drifted snow, especially on northern slopes.








Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Mostly cloudy skies. Variable in the afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Mostly cloudy skies. In the Carnic, Julian, and Canin Alps, avalanche danger will be 2(moderate). On very steep slopes, above 1800-1900 m and at all exposures, in areas withwind-drifted snow accumulations, triggered avalanches, generally small in size, will bepossible with high overload. Locally, at the highest altitudes and mainly in the north and onextreme slopes, triggered avalanches with low overload is not excluded. Residualavalanches are possible on sunny slopes. In the Pre-Alps and Alps below 1800-1900 m,avalanche danger will be 1 (low). On steep slopes, especially in the north, triggered smallavalanches are possible, in areas with wind-drifted snow accumulations, generally withhigh overload. Chance of isolated avalanches also on sunny slopes. Beware of the risk ofslipping on icy areas or areas leveled out by wind.

Forecast for Saturday 20 March 2021, reliability: 70%

At high altitudes, locally unstable wind-drifted snow, especially on northern slopes.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather expected with continued low temperatures. In the Carnic, Julian, and Canin Alps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate). On very steep slopes, above 1800-1900 m and atall exposures, in areas with wind-drifted snow accumulations, triggered avalanches, generally small in size, will be possible with high overload. Locally, at the highest altitudesand mainly in the north and on extreme slopes, triggered avalanches with low overload isnot excluded. Residual avalanches are possible on sunny slopes. In the Pre-Alps and Alpsbelow 1800-1900 m, avalanche danger will be 1 (low). On steep slopes, especially in thenorth, triggered small avalanches are possible, in areas with wind-drifted snowaccumulations, generally with high overload. Chance of isolated avalanches also on sunnyslopes. Beware of the risk of slipping on icy areas or areas leveled out by wind.
