









Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies with increasing temperatures. In the Alps and Canin area, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate):above 1800-1900 m, especially on shady slopes. Isolated wind-drifted accumulations of snow are stillpresent which, if mainly stressed with a high overload, can cause triggered avalanches. During the warmesthours, at all exposures on very steep slopes, avalanches can even occur with the passage of single skiers-hiker. These can, in some cases, reach medium size. On the Prealps, avalanche danger is 1 (weak) in themorning, increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning: in the north, on very steep slopes and in very isolatedareas, small triggered avalanches are possible, especially with high overload. Throughout the territory, fromlate morning, on steep sunny slopes, chance of small- and medium-sized natural avalanches of wet snow,and/or slip avalanches on steep grassy slopes.

Forecast for Tuesday 30 March 2021, reliability: 80%

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies with a further rise in temperatures and consequent increase in the possibility of avalanches, especially on sunnier slopes. On the Alps and in the Canin area, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate):isolated wind-drifted accumulations of snow present at high altitudes, if stressed with a high overload, maycause small triggered avalanche. However, during the warmest hours, at all exposures on very steep slopes, avalanches can even occur with passage of single skiers-hikers, also reaching medium-size. In the Prealps, avalanche danger will be 1 (weak) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate) from late morning: in the northon the steepest slopes and in very isolated areas, small triggered avalanches are possible, generally with ahigh overload. Throughout the territory, from the morning, on steep sunny slopes, chance small- andmedium-sized natural avalanches of wet snow, and/or slip avalanches on steep grassy slopes.




