










Mostly cloudy skies. Chance of moderate scattered rain showers, even thunderstorms, especially inthe afternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Mostly cloudy skies with the possibility of scattered rain showers and thunderstorms. Snow willonly fall on the tops of the highest mountains. The snowpack is generally wet on the surface, due torain and high temperatures. Throughout the entire territory, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate). Onsteep slopes at all exposures, medium and, in some cases, large wet-snow avalanches are possibleon snowier northern slopes. Wet-snow avalanches may be triggered on the superficial layers of thesnowpack even with the passage of single skiers-hikers and may even reach medium size.

# Forecast for Saturday 01 May 2021, reliability: 70%

## Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Variable skies, chance of local showers. During the night into Sunday, a marked deterioration is likely.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable cloudiness with possible scattered rain showers and some thunderstorms. From the evening, conditions will probably worsenwith widespread rainfall. Throughout the entire territory avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) increasing to 3 (considerable) during theday. The predicted weather conditions and high temperatures will lead to an increased instability of the snowpack. On steep slopes, atall exposures, medium and, in some cases, large wet-snow avalanches will be possible. On snowier northern slopes, very large isolatedphenomena may occur. Wet-snow avalanches may be triggered even with the passage of single skiers-hikers and locally may even belarge in size.














#### Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Variable cloudiness, continued showers and scattered thunderstorms. Abundant snowfall above 1500 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During the night, abundant to intense rainfall in all areas, accompanied by strong winds, variability during the day with continuedshowers. 20-30 cm of new snow may fall above 2000 m and, starting in the evening, chance of snow 1500-1600 m. Throughout theentire territory, avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable). The forecasted meteorological conditions will determine an increase of theinstability of the snowpack. On steep slopes, at all exposures, wet-snow avalanches, even large ones, are possible and, on isolatednorthern slopes, very large in size. Slip avalanches on very steep grassy slopes are also possible. Wet-snow avalanches may betriggered even with the passage of single skiers-hikers and may also be large in size. Above 2000 m, chance of triggered release slabsof new snow with low overload. Unfavorable conditions for excursions.

# Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Generally variable skies. Chance of several showers and thunderstorms.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies with some weak snowfall above approx. 1600 m. A drop in temperatures is expected. Throughout the territory, avalanchedanger will continue to be 3 (considerable). On steep slopes at all exposures, wet-snow avalanches of medium and, in some cases,large ones, will be possible, especially below 2000 m. Wet-snow avalanches may still be triggered even with the passage of singleskiers-hikers and locally may even be large in size. Above 2000 m on steep slopes with wind-drifted accumulations, triggeredavalanches with dry snow slabs may occur even with the passage of single skiers-hikers. Avalanches at a local may also affect part ofthe old wet snowpack, therefore, becoming large in size.
