




Variable weather in innermost areas. Cloudy, chance of precipitation in the Pre-Alps.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies and freezing temperatures at 2400 m. More cloud cover expected in the Pre-Alps. The snowpack is slowly consolidating but still contains several fragile layers. In the Alps, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate). On very steep slopes above approximately 1900-2000 m,in areas with old wind-blown accumulations, and especially at northern exposures and onsteep slopes, chance of triggered avalanches with high overload, causing small- and medium-sized isolated avalanches. In the Pre-Alps, danger is 1 (weak). Some triggered avalanches arepossible on the steep slopes in summit areas of northern exposures.

Forecast for Saturday 25 December 2021, reliability: 70%

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies, possible weak precipitation in eastern areas (0-10 cm) of new snow aboveapproximately 1300-1600 m, which will not affect the degree of avalanche danger. In the Alps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate). Above approximately 1900 m, especially at northernexposures, continued chance of triggered small-sized avalanches and isolated medium-sizedavalanches on very steep slopes, mainly with high overload. In the Pre-Alps, avalanchedanger will be 1 (weak). Chance of triggered avalanches on steep slopes in summit areas. Inthe areas affected by possible snowfall, isolated avalanches from the steepest slopes androcky crags are possible. 

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Continuous cloudy skies and uncertain forecast. Weak precipitation on the Julian Alps and Canin area (0-10cm), possible snow depth approximately 1000-1200 m, which will not affect the degree of avalanchedanger. In the Alps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate). Above approximately 1900 m, especially atnorthern exposures, continued chance of triggered small-sized avalanches and isolatedmedium-sized avalanches on very steep slopes, mainly with high overload. In the Pre-Alps, avalanche danger will be 1 (weak). Chance of triggered avalanches on steep slopes in summitareas.
