





Situation of 10 December 2021 edition of the hours 14-next update 13-12-2021 hours 14, forecaster: MM


Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: In the morning, partly cloudy then overcast.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy to overcast skies. The snowpack is weakly consolidated on most steep slopes, due to thepresence of new and old unstable wind-blown accumulations. On the Julian Alps and Canin area, avalanche danger is 4 (high), also under the tree line on steep slopes at all exposures, chance of bothnatural and triggered avalanches, even large-sized, is likely, the latter even with low overload. On the Carnic Alps and Prealps, avalanche danger is 3 (considerable), even below the treeline on steep slopesat all exposures, chance of both natural and triggered avalanches of medium size, the latter generallywith a high overload. Locally, avalanches are not excluded, even with a low overload and of a largersize. Triggered ground avalanches are also possible throughout the territory, also involving roads thatare normally subject to avalanches, generally above 1000 m.

Forecast for Saturday 11 December 2021, reliability: 70%

Avalanche danger 4 (high): Julian Alps and Canin area; 3 (considerable): on Carnic Alps and Prealps.

north at high altitudes.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies. The snowpack will still be weakly consolidated on most of the steep slopes, due to thepresence of old and new, unstable wind-blown accumulations. On the Julian Alps and in the Canin area, avalanche danger will be 4 (high), also under the tree line on steep slopes at all exposures, chance ofavalanches, even large in size, both natural and triggered, the latter even with a low overload. On the Carnic Alps and Prealps, avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable), even below the treeline on steep slopesat all exposures, chance of both natural and triggered avalanches of medium size is likely, the lattergenerally with a high overload. Locally, avalanches are not excluded, even with a low overload and of alarger size. Triggered ground avalanches are also possible throughout the territory, also involving roadsthat are normally subject to avalanches, especially at higher altitudes.





Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy skies and moderate norht wind at high altitudes.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies. The snowpack will slowly tend to consolidate, even if the presence of unstable windblownaccumulations will remain, especially at high altitudes. On the Alps and Prealps, avalanche danger willbe 3 (considerable), generally above the treeline on steep slopes at all exposures, chance of triggeredmedium- and large-sized avalanches, even with low overload on higher slopes. Locally, larger-sizedavalanches are not excluded. Natural activity will generally be decreasing. Throughout the territory, butespecially on the sunnier sides of steep grassy slopes, triggered ground avalanches will also bepossible.

Forecast for Monday 13 December 2021, reliability: 70%

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Slightly cloudy skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies with rising temperatures that could cause an increase in natural avalanche activity,particularly on slopes more exposed to the sun and near rocky areas. Especially at high altitudes, thepresence of unstable wind-blown accumulationswill remain. On the Alps and Prealps, avalanche dangerwill be 3 (considerable). Generally above the treeline on steep slopes at all exposures, medium- andlarge-sized avalanches will be possible, both natural and triggered, the latter especially on steeperslopes, even with a low overload. Locally, larger avalanches are not excluded. Throughout the territory, but especially on the sunnier sides of steep grassy slopes, triggered ground avalanches will also bepossible
