



Chance of triggered avalanches even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies and falling temperatures. Due to recent snowfall, the snowpack is moderatelyconsolidated on many steep slopes, especially in areas where snow has not yet detached andwhere wind has caused the formation of unstable snow accumulations. The most dangerousareas are, therefore, found under ridges, passes, and along gullies. Avalanche danger is 3(considerable) throughout the mountain area. Generally, above the treeline, at all exposureson steep slopes, chance of triggered avalanches even with the passage of single skiers andhikers. Natural avalanches from very steep slopes from which snow has not yet detached arestill possible. Avalanches may generally be medium-sized, with larger ones not excluded on alocal level, especially in the Julian Alps and Canin area, where recent snowfalls have beenmore abundant.

Forecast for Saturday 08 January 2022, reliability: 70% Chance of triggered avalanches even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Slightly cloudy with very low temperatures that will favor the formation of weak layers withinthe snowpack, especially under slabs formed by the wind, which will represent the greatestsource of avalanche danger. The most dangerous areas, therefore, will be found under ridges, passes, and along gullies. Avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) on the Alps and in theCanin area. Generally, beyond the tree line, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance oftriggered avalanches even with the passage of single skiers and hikers. Avalanches maygenerally be medium-sized, with larger ones not excluded on a local level, especially in theJulian Alps and in the Canin area. Avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) in the Prealps.Generally, above the treeline, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance of triggered small- andmedium-sized avalanches, mainly with high overload. Natural avalanches will be limitedthroughout the territory.



Chance of weak snowfall, which could make dangerousareas less visible. Avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) on the Alps and in the Canin area.Generally, beyond the tree line, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance of triggeredavalanches even with the passage of single skiers and hikers. Avalanches may generally bemedium-sized, with larger ones not excluded on a local level, especially in the Julian Alps andCanin area. Avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) in the Prealps. Generally, above thetreeline, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance of triggered small- and medium-sizedavalanches, mainly with high overload. Natural avalanches will be limited throughout theterritory.

Forecast for Monday 10 January 2022, reliability: 60%

In the Alps and Canin area, chance of triggered avalanches even with low overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies with wind at high altitudes, which may cause further unstable snowaccumulations, especially along gullies, and in passes and ridges. Low temperatures will stillfavor the formation of weak layers. Avalanche danger will be 3 (considerable) on the Alps andin the Canin area. Generally, beyond the tree line, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance oftriggered avalanches even with the passage of single skiers and hikers. Avalanches maygenerally be medium-sized, with larger ones not excluded on a local level, especially in theJulian Alps and Canin area. Avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) in the Prealps. General, above the treeline, at all exposures on steep slopes, chance of triggered small- and medium-sized avalanches, mainly with high overload. Natural avalanches will be limited throughoutthe territory.
