



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is generally stable and well bonded on most slopes. In shadier areas, hard and frozensnow slabs are present, as well as areas with loose artificial snow. On slopes most exposed to the sun, it is characterized by superficial layers. In the south, in the Prealps, little or no snow is present. Avalanche danger is 1 (low) throughout the territory. At high altitudes on very steep slopes, with thepresence of windblown snow accumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered small avalanches, mainly with high overload. Natural avalanches are also possible from areas exposed to the sun, especially from slopes and near rocks. Beware of areas with hard orfrozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.

Forecast for Thursday 27 January 2022, reliability: 80% Chance of small triggered avalanches at high altitudes, generally with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable early mornings skies, then clear or partly cloudy with mild temperatures at high altitudes which, on sunnier slopes, may favor natural avalanche activity, especially near rocky areas. Avalanche dangerwill be 1 (low) throughout the territory. At high altitudes on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blown snow accumulations in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance oftriggered small avalanches, mainly with high overload. The most dangerous areas will be ridges, forks, and along very steep gullies, and also areas with little snow where there may be gaps at the base of theold snowpack. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.




Forecast for Friday 28 January 2022, reliability: 70%

Strong wind from N at high altitudes, chance of new wind-blown accumulations.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies with sharply decreasing temperatures and moderate to high wind from the north west athigh altitudes, which may favor the formation of new wind-blown snow accumulations, especially inareas most subject to wind, such as forks, ridges, and along gullies . Avalanche danger will be 1 (low)throughout the territory. At high altitudes on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blown snowaccumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered smallavalanches, mainly with high overload. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk ofslipping and falling.

Forecast for Saturday 29 January 2022, reliability: 70% Chance of small triggered avalanches at high altitudes, generally with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies with a further slight drop in temperatures. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) throughoutthe territory. At high altitudes on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blown snowaccumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered smallavalanches, mainly with high overload. The most dangerous areas will be ridges, forks, and along verysteep gullies, and also areas with little snow where there may be gaps at the base of the old snowpack.
