

Situation of 28 January 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 28-01-2022 hours 14, forecaster: MM Strong NW wind at high altitude, with possible formation of new wind-blown accumulations



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is generally stable and well consolidated on most slopes. In shadier areas, hard andfrozen snow slabs are present, as well as areas with loose artificial snow. On slopes most exposed tothe sun, it is characterized by superficial layers. In the south, in the Prealps, little or no snow is present. During the day, strong NW winds high altitudes are expected, which could lead to the formation of newaccumulations of wind-blown snow, especially in areas most subject to wind, such as ridges, forks, andalong gullies. Avalanche danger is 1 (low) throughout the territory. At high altitudes on very steepslopes, with the presence of wind-blown snow accumulations, in localized areas, and especially atnorthern exposures, chance of triggering small avalanches, mainly with high overload. Beware of areaswith hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.

Forecast for Saturday 29 January 2022, reliability: 80%

At high altitudes, chance of triggered small avalanches is possible, generally with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast sky at night and in the morning, variable during the day. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low)throughout the territory. At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blownaccumulations of snow, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggeredsmall avalanches, mainly with high overload. The most dangerous areas will be ridges, forks, and alongvery steep gullies, as well as areas with little snow where there may also be gaps at the base of the oldsnowpack. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.

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




Forecast for Sunday 30 January 2022, reliability: 70% At high altitudes, chance of triggered small avalanches, generally with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear or partly cloudy skies with slightly rising temperatures and moderate to locally high NW wind athigh altitudes, which may favor the formation of new wind-blown accumulations. Avalanche danger willbe 1 (low)throughout the territory. At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blown accumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggeredsmall avalanches, mainly with high overload. The most dangerous areas will be ridges, forks, and alongvery steep gullies, as well as areas with little snow where there may also be gaps at the base of the oldsnowpack. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.

Forecast for Monday 31 January 2022, reliability: 70% At high altitudes, chance of triggered small avalanches, generally with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies, with a slight drop in temperatures. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) throughout theterritory. At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blown accumulations, inlocalized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered small avalanches, mainlywith high overload. The most dangerous sites will be ridges, forks, and along very steep gullies, as wellas areas with little snow, where there may also be gaps at the base of the old snowpack. Beware ofareas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.
