




Situation of 07 February 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 09-02-2022 hours 14, forecaster: GA



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Very weak snowfall affected the mountain range, with greater quantities in the Sappada area. Strong wind blowing from N-NW at high altitudes, which contributes to forming new small accumulations in the more sheltered basinsand gullies. These small accumulations may present a modest consolidation with the old snowpack locally, characterized by hard surface layers and, if locally overloaded, they may detach, even with the passage of individual skiers or hikers. The dangerous points are generally very isolated, except for the Sappada area, where they are slightly greater diffused. Assess risk of slipping and falling. Avalanche danger is generally 1 (low) but could be 2 (moderate) in the Sappada area and on Monte Coglians.

Forecast for Tuesday 08 February 2022, reliability: 80%

Chance of triggered small avalanches at high altitudes, generally with highoverload.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear or partly cloudy skies. NW wind at high altitudes in the morning. Increasedtemperatures during the day.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather, with wind continuing in the morning. A rise in temperature isexpected during the day. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low,) except for the Sappada area and on Monte Coglians, where it will be 2 (moderate). At highaltitudes, recently formed snow deposits in areas located on very steep slopes, may detach locally if overloaded, even at passage of single skiers or hikers. Inthe Sappada area and on Monte Coglians, the diffusion of these dangerouspoints will be slightly greater and will already be present above the treeline. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling. During warmer hours, chance small moist-snow avalanches from slopes and along steeper slopes in the sun.

















Forecast for Wednesday 09 February 2022, reliability: 70%


Avalanche danger 1 (weak) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate), due toheat.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies with freezing temperatures at 3000 m. Avalanche danger will be 1(weak) in the morning, rising to 2 (moderate) in the afternoon throughout thearea. In the morning, on very steep slopes at high altitudes, with the presence ofwind-blown snow accumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northernexposures, chance of triggered small avalanches, mainly with high overload. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling During warmer hours, small- or, at most, chance of medium-sized naturalavalanches of damp or wet snow from mainly sunny steeper slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 10 February 2022, reliability: 70%

Avalanche danger 1 (weak) in the morning, increasing to 2 (moderate), due toheat.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy to overcast skies in the Prealps, slightly cloudy in Carnia and Tarvisio. Avalanche danger will be 1 (weak) in the morning, rising to 2 (moderate) in theafternoon throughout the area. In the morning on very steep slopes at highaltitudes, with the presence of wind-blown snow accumulations, in localizedareas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered smallavalanches, mainly with high overload. Beware of areas with hard or frozensnow. Along steeper slopes, chance of small- or medium-sized naturalavalanches of damp or wet snow during warmer hours, even below the treeline.
