




Situation of 09 February 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 11-02-2022 hours 14, forecaster: GA


Stable weather with clear or partly cloudy skies. Marked thermal inversion.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snowpack is generally stable and well consolidated, mainly characterized by superficial layersof varying hardness and wind-blown accumulations. Areas with superficial loose snow remain inshadier areas in the woods. On southern slopes, little or no snow present up to high altitudes. Avalanche danger is 1 (low) throughout the entire mountain area. On very steep slopes, in areaslocated especially at higher altitudes, chance of triggered small slab avalanches, with a generallyhigh additional load. With the warmer weather on steeper southern slopes, chance of small naturalavalanches.

Forecast for Thursday 10 February 2022, reliability: 90%

At high altitude, on very steep slopes, chance of locally unstable wind-blown accumulations.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Clear in the morning, cloudy in the afternoon, starting in the Prealps. Chance of very weak snowfallover 1000 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Good weather in the morning with increased cloudiness in the afternoon, starting on the Prealps. Starting in the evening, chance of very weak snowfall above 1000m. Avalanche danger will be 1(low) throughout the entire mountain territory. At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, snowdeposits present in localized areas that, if overloaded, may still originate several small avalanches, with a generally high additional load. Assess risk of slipping and falling. Beware of to areas withhard or frozen snow. Wet snowfall is still possible on steeper southern slopes.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

During the night, weak precipitation on the Julian Pre-Alps. Cloudy in the morning. Clear in theafternoon.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: During the night, chance of weak precipitation on the Julian Pre-Alps. In the morning, cloudy toovercast skies. Clearing, starting in the afternoon from Carnia. The expected low rainfall will notaffect the avalanche danger, which will continue to be 1 (weak) throughout. At high altitudes, onvery steep slopes with wind-blown accumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northernexposures, chance of triggered small avalanches with a generally high additional overload. Bewareof areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.

Forecast for Saturday 12 February 2022, reliability: 80%

At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, chance of locally unstable wind-blown accumulations.

At high altitudes, on very steep slopes, with the presence of wind-blownaccumulations, in localized areas, and especially at northern exposures, chance of triggered smallavalanches with a generally high additional overload. Beware of areas with hard or frozen snow. Assess risk of slipping and falling.
