



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: The snow cover is generally stable and well consolidated. In many areas, only a slight amount of snow willbe present. On sunny slopes, no snow below approximately 1700 m. Wind-blown accumulations on anisolated level on very steep shady slopes are not yet well consolidated with the old snow. In the centralportion of the snow cover on shady slopes, fragile layers with large grains are present. Avalanches dangeris generally 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory. On extreme shady steep slopes above 1800-2000 m,and with high overload on an isolated level, chance of an triggered small avalanches in areas with wind-blown accumulations. With high overload, on a very isolated level, chance of avalanches also in the oldsnow on steep northern extremes above approximately 2000 m. Beware of areas with hard or icy snow.

Forecast for Saturday 05 March 2022, reliability: 90%

In the central portion of the snow cover, on avery isolated level, fragile layers are present, especially on shady slopes above about 2000 m. Avalanchedanger is generally 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory. On extreme shady steep slopes above 1800-2000 m, and with high overload, on an isolated level, chance of triggered small avalanches in areas withwind-blown accumulations. 


To the north, at high altitudes, chance of triggered small avalanches, mainly with high overload.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Clear skies or slightly cloudy. The snow cover is stable overall. In many areas, only a slight amount of snowwill be present and, on most sunny slopes, there will be no snow below 1700 m. Wind-blownaccumulations at high altitudes are generally well consolidated with the old snow. In the central portion ofthe snow cover, on a very isolated level, fragile layers are present, especially on shady slopes aboveapproximately 2000 m. Avalanche danger is generally 1 (low) throughout the mountain territory On extreme shady steep slopes above 1800-2000 m, and with high overload, on an isolated level, chance oftriggered small avalanches in areas with wind-blown accumulations. With high overload, on a very isolatedlevel, avalanches may also occur in the old snow on steep northern extremes above approximately 2000 m.Beware of areas with hard or icy snow.
