



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Skies are mostly clear. The snow cover in the morning is stable and well consolidated. With a daytime rise intemperatures and the heat of the sun, the snow cover will tend to become wet and weaken on the surface. Beware of hard, icy surfaces. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) throughout the territory. During warmerhours of the day along very steep snow-covered slopes to the south and north below 2000-2100 m, chancewet-snow avalanches, generally small in size, or medium in size only at an isolated level. During warmerhours and on steep slopes, wet-snow avalanches can break away when skiing.

Forecast for Tuesday 29 March 2022, reliability: 80%

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Generally cloudless skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Skies are generally cloudless. The snow cover in the morning is stable and well consolidated. With adaytime rise in temperatures and the heat of the sun, the snow cover will tend to become wet and weakenon the surface. Beware of hard, icy surfaces. Avalanche danger will be 1 (low) throughout the territory. During warmer hours of the day along very steep snow-covered slopes to the south and north below 2000-2100 m, chance wet-snow avalanches, generally small in size, or medium in size only at an isolated level. During warmer hours and on steep slopes, wet-snow avalanches can break away when skiing.





Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Cloudy skies with light snowfall starting in the afternoon/evening.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Weak precipitation is expected starting in the afternoon and more likely towards the evening. Snow above 1400 m. Avalanche danger will continue to remain 1 (low) throughout the territory. Above 2000 m, on verysteep northern slopes in shady areas, chance of generally small avalanches, in isolated cases, mainly with ahigh overload, due to the presence of fragile layers within the snow cover on a local level. Starting in theafternoon into the evening, fresh-snow avalanches are possible on the highest slopes, with weak cohesion.

Forecast for Thursday 31 March 2022, reliability: 60%

Increased risk of avalanches due to new snowfall.



Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Moderate to abundant precipitation is expected throughout the entire mountain territory, snowfall generallyover 1200 m and in the valley of the Tarvisian area. At high altitudes, moderate southwestern winds willblow. The expected avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate), increasing to 3 (considerable) during the day.
