






Slightly cloudy in Tarvisio. In the Prealps and Carnia region, mainly cloudy. Moderate SW wind at highaltitude.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Due to a significant increase in temperature in the afternoon, avalanche danger is 3 (considerable) in the Julian Alps and in Canin area. Above the treeline on very steep slopes, chance of natural small- and medium-sized damp- or wet-snow, also large in certain areas, especially on sunny slopes. Triggered small-or medium- sized avalanches are also possible, even with the passage of individual skiers or hikers. In theCarnic Alps and Prealps, avalanche danger is 2 (moderate). Avalanche phenomena are generally small, butseveral larger avalanches are not excluded. On steep southern grassy slopes, glide avalanches are alsopossible throughout.

Forecast for Thursday 07 April 2022, reliability: 70%

Avalanche danger 2 (moderate) throughout the entire mountain territory.

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG:

Variable skies with humid atmosphere towards evening; covered skies.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Variable skies in the morning, cloudy in the afternoon. Freezing temperatures at 2500. Avalanche danger willbe 2 (moderate) throughout the mountain territory. In the morning, on very steep northern slopes at highaltitudes, chance of triggered avalanches with high overload, which extends into the warmer hours on verysteep slopes above the treeline al all exposures, with small- or medium-sized avalanches on a local level, even with the passage of a individual skiers or hikers. During warmer hours, natural small- and medium-sized wet-snow avalanches are possible, especially on sunny slopes. On steep southern grassy slopes, chance of avalanches throughout.


Thermal Zero: 2800 m T.average 1000: 8 °C T.average 2000: 3 °C

Weather by OSMER - ARPA FVG: Covered skies with light rain from the afternoon and moderate SW winds at high altitudes.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Cloudy skies with light rainfall at the highest altitudes. Extremely damp and heavy snow cover. Avalanchedanger will be 2 (moderate) rising to 3 (considerable) on the Alps during the day. With a rise in daytimetemperature and rain during the day, above the treeline on very steep slopes, chance of natural andtriggered avalanches, even with the passage of individual skiers or hikers. Avalanches will be small andmedium in size, and in several cases large, especially on northern slopes with high overloaded. On the Prealps, avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate). Avalanches will be generally small, but larger ones are notexcluded on northern slopes. On steep southern grassy slopes, chance of glide avalanches throughout.

Forecast for Saturday 09 April 2022, reliability: 60%

Overcast skies with chance of light snowfall up to approximately 1200 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: Overcast skies and decreasing temperatures. Predicted weak snowfall over 1200 m with moderatestrongwinds. Avalanche danger will be 2 (moderate) throughout the mountain territory.
