




Situation of 11 April 2022 edition of the hours 14-next update 13-04-2022 hours 14, forecaster: GA


Clear or slightly cloudy skies, milder during day at high altitudes, increasing freezing point at approx. 3000 m.

Snow cover conditions and avalanche danger: On Saturday, 20 to 40 cm of new snow fell at 1800 m. Higher temperatures locally where storms were moreintense. The new snow has consolidated well with the old snow. Wind at high altitudes has formed newaccumulations in basins, gullies, and near the ridges. Significant increase in temperatures today in theafternoon. Avalanche danger is 2 (moderate) on the Julian Alps and in the Canin area above 1800 m and onthe Carnic Alps above approximately 2300 m. In these areas, on very steep southern slopes, natural damp-or wet-snow avalanches. Triggered slab avalanches are possible on steep slopes, generally with highoverload. Expected avalanche phenomena will be medium in size. On the Prealps, Alps, and Canin areabelow above mentioned altitudes, avalanche danger is 1 (low). Chance of wet-snow avalanches, generallysmall in size.

Forecast for Tuesday 12 April 2022, reliability: 80%




